William Henry Smith, 75, veteran street railway employe, who operated the first trolley car on the South Portland Cape Elizabeth line and the last one out of that city July 21, 1940, upon the Cumberland County Power & Light Company discontinuing that service, died Saturday at his home, 422 Preble Street, in the Cape City.

He was the last of the motormen who operated on the Cape line when it was established and for 37 years was employed on it before his retirement in 1933 He came out of retirement on the morning of July 21, 1940, to have a part in writing the last chapter of the electric car service as motorman on the final trip on the line.




