

Charles E. Snow, the well known contractor, died at his residence, in Portland, Feb. 14th. He had been sick for several weeks, but it was hoped that he would recover, and for a short time his condition seemed to improve. The cause of his death was heart failure.

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Mr. Snow was born in Scarboro, October 29, 1847, and came to Portland when a young man and entered into the business of mason and contractor, always continuing in this line and becoming very succesful. 




