Five minutes after he had been returned to his room at the Maine General Hospital early this morning, after walking into a ward, Artell H. Somers, 72, of Kennebunk, disrobed, opened a window and jumped 35 feet to his death. He struck on his head on a concrete walk in the rear of the hospital.

Late Thursday afternoon Somers was put under restraint in his second-floor room when he refused to stay in bed, hospital officials reported. An hour later the re-

straining straps were removed. At 4.20 a. m. he again left his bed.

Dr. Wilbur F. Leighton, medical examiner, who ruled the death a suicide, said Somers was instantly killed. He had been a patient at the institution several days.

Mary O'Donnell, in charge of Ward F on the second floor, said she and two student nurses accompanied Somers to his room after he had attempted to enter the ward. The door of his room was closed on him and the room was empty when the door was opened a few seconds later.

Dr. Stephen S. Brown, director of the hospital, explained Somers had been disturbed and insisted on leaving his room. After restraining straps were placed on the patient, Dr. Brown said, an interne talked with him and ordered the straps removed after the patient had regained his composure. Attendants said he had not talked of suicide.

Mr. Somers was the son of Israel and Olive Hatch Somers, and had resided at Kennebunk many years. In early manhood he was employed as a locomotive engineer by the Boston & Maine Railroad, subsequently entering the employ of the Keyes Fiber Co. of Kennebunk. In recent years he had engaged in farming and had been employed also as night watchman by the fiber company. He was a past noble grand of Mousam Lodge, IOOF, and a member of York Lodge of Masons, both of Kennebunk.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Rachel Furbish Somers, whom he married July 5, 1886.
