EMBDEN — David W. Spaulding, 64, of Embden, formerly of Stratton, died Friday at Maine Medical Center in Portland where he had been a patient for two weeks after a long illness of cancer.

He was born Jan. 30, 1930 in Princeton, the son of Earl E. and Esther W. (French) Spaulding. He was educated in Hampden schools and graduated from Hampden Academy in 1948 and Kents Hill in 1949. He was also a graduate of New York State Ranger School in 1951. He enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1951, received commission from Officer Candidate School and was stationed at Fort Belvoir Corps of Engineering, U.S. Army Map Service, Fort Presido, Calif., and in the Philippines during the Korean War. He married Diane LeClair Dec. 3, 1959 in Stratton. He was employed by St. Croix Paper Co., Dead River, Inc. for several years. He was a self-employed logging contractor in Langtown Township, Stratton, for most of his life before retiring 10 years ago.

He served as selectman for the Town of Eustis for 18 years; served on the SAD 58 board of directors; and Norstar Bank board of directors in Farmington. Mr. Spaulding was a member of the Mt. Bigelow Masonic Lodge 202 AF&AM of Stratton; Franklin Chapter 34 Royal Arch Masons of Farmington; Pilgrim Commandry 19, Knights Templar of Farmington; and Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston. He enjoyed sports, fly fishing, skiing, tennis with his wife and football.

Mr. Spaulding is survived by his wife, Diane, of Embden; two sons, Jeffrey W. Spaulding of Auburn and Steven F. Spaulding of Madison; and two sisters, Mary Dickey of Orono and Margaret Brooks of Bangor.

GREENVILLE (AP) — Two persons were dead and three others missing Sunday night after a fire destroyed a rambling wood-frame resort in this northern Maine community

Two bodies, burned beyond recognition, were pulled from the ruins of the fashionable Squaw Mountain Inn earlier in the day. State police said dental records of the persons would be examined in an effort to identify them.

Later, authorities identified one body as Douglas R. Spaulding, 55, of Skowhegan. Spaulding was listed as one of five persons missing.

"The area is just too hot to search right now," said State Police Trooper Marvin Jones. "We intend to wet down the area all night and begin looking in the morning."
