SCARBOROUGH — William F. Spear, of Teal Point Drive, died Feb. 13, 2000, after a long illness.

He was born in Portland, a son of Willard Walker and Isabelle Werner Spear, and graduated from South Portland schools and the University of Maine at Orono.

During World War II, Mr. Spear attended Bates College in the Navy V-12 College Training Program. He served in the V-5 Naval Aviation Flight Training Program at the Williams College Flight-Preparatory School, the University of North Carolina Pre-Flight School, the Naval Air Station Glenview, Ill., Primary Flight Training School, and the Naval Air Station (Pensacola, Fla.) Advanced Flight Training Facility.

He was recalled to active duty in the Naval Reserve Training Unit for service with the North Atlantic Fleet during the Korean War.

Capt. Spear worked for Hartford Fire Insurance Co. in Hartford, Conn., and then for United Airlines of Chicago, retiring after 30 years with more than 20,000 flight hours.

He was a member of the first Adult Education Committee in Hartford, co-director of the Southwestern New Hampshire Mosquito Control Committee, a committee member of an Employee Assistance Program backed by the Air Line Pilots Association, and the National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism, and was an aeromedical coordinator for local councils and the master executive committee of the A.L.P.A. of United Airlines.

Capt. Spear was a member of Hiram Lodge of South Portland, a 32nd Degree member of the Maine Consistory, a member and supporter of the International Order of the Shrine, a life member of Sigma Chi Fraternity and the A.L.P.A., and a past member of the Maine Pilots Association. He was a previous office-holder in the Greater Maine Ocean Racing Society and a member of the Retired United Pilots Association.

Surviving are his wife of 48 years, Patricia Love Spear of Scarborough; a son, Timothy of Scarborough; two daughters, Suzanne Grogan of Franklin, Mass., and Jane Spear of Nahant, Mass.; three brothers, Donald H. of Cape Elizabeth, Robert W. of Ocean Springs, Miss., and Willard W. Jr. of Dayton, Nev.; a sister, Mrs. Donald (Virginia) Williams of Traverse City, Mich.; and three grandchildren.

Visiting hours will be held from 2 to 4 and 7 to 9 p.m. Tuesday at Hobbs Funeral Home, 230 Cottage Road, South Portland, where the Hiram Lodge will conduct a Masonic memorial service at 7:30 p.m. A funeral service will be held at the funeral home at 11 a.m. Wednesday. Spring burial will be in Riverside Cemetery, Cape Elizabeth.

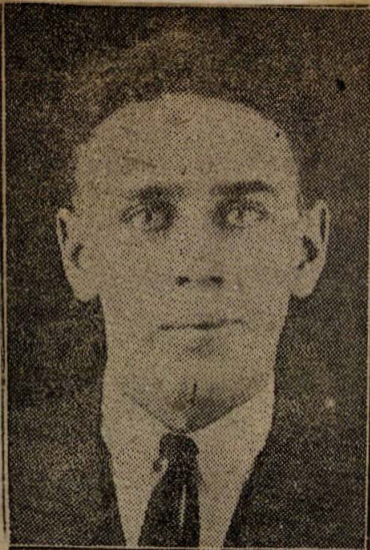

**North Berwick** — Wilbur Daniel Spencer, former state representative, state senator and Maine insurance commissioner, died here yesterday after a long illness.

He was born at Berwick, Jan. 24, 1872, son of Daniel Wentworth and Amanda Prescott Spencer. He was educated in Berwick and Somersworth, N. H., and was graduated from Dartmouth College in 1895. He was admitted to the bar in 1899.

After serving as superintendent of schools and town clerk at Berwick, Mr. Spencer was elected to the Maine House in 1913 and to the Maine Senate in 1921 and 1923. He was named state insurance commissioner by Gov. Percival Baxter in 1923 and reappointed to the post for a second four-year term in 1927.

Mr. Spencer also was the author of several books about Maine, including *The Maine Spencers*, *Berwick Revolutionary Soldiers*, *Pioneers on Maine Rivers*, and a novel, *Princess Of The Indies*. He was a member of St. John's Lodge, AF&AM, and Rathbone Lodge, K of P, and of the Methodist Church. His wife, Mrs. Florence May Ford Spencer, died in 1936. He is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Adel Ellis, Mrs. Selva Coombs and Mrs. Mabel Shirley, and a son, Wilbur W. Spencer.

Funeral will be at 2 p. m. Friday at Hill Memorial Chapel, the Rev. Dwight McMann officiating. Masonic services will also be held. Interment will be in Evergreen Cemetery.
