Funeral services for Albert Gardner Spicer, former Portland resident who died Wednesday in his home, 79 Lake Place, New Haven, Conn., will be held at 1 p. m. today in the funeral parlors of Beecher & Bennett, 100 Broadway, New Haven, Conn. The Rev. Roy Hendricks, pastor of the Shelton, Conn., Methodist Church, will officiate. Interment will be in Maplewood Cemetery, Norwich.

Mr. Spicer was born July 17, 1869, at Hyde Park, Vt. From 1910 to 1924 during his residence here, he was in charge of the Congress Square Hotel news stand. BIDDEFORD — Louis Spill, 68, a longtime Biddeford attorney, died Tuesday in a Portland hospital after a long illness.

He was born here, a son of Abraham and Rebecca (Green) Spill. He attended local schools, graduated from Biddeford High School, and received a law degree from Portland School of Law in 1937.

He served in the U.S. Army Air Corps military intelligence division during World War II.

Mr. Spill began law practice in Kennebunk, and eventually moved to Biddeford where for many years he practiced in association with his brother, Judge Simon Spill.

He was a member of the Maine and York County bar associations and American Trial Lawyers Association and was a former commander of the State of Maine Jewish War Veterans.

He also was a member of the Knights

of Pythias, Kennebunk Grange, Biddeford-Saco Elks, Dunlap Lodge of Ancient & Free Masons and Kora Shrine Temple.

A past president of B'nai B'rith, he was secretary of Congregation Etz Chaim, and a member of Temple Beth El, Portland.

Besides his brother, Simon, he leaves his widow, Martha Fleet Spill; a daughter, Sandra Spill of Newburyport, Mass.; and a son, Richard of McLean, Va.

A funeral will be held at noon Thursday at Congregational Etz Chaim, Bacon Street. Rabbi Harry Z. Sky will officiate. Burial will follow in Mount Carmel Cemetery, Hicks Street, Portland.

Retired District Court Judge Simon Spill, 80, Biddeford, died Friday at Maine Medical Center, 2-3-71.

He was appointed to the district court by then-Gov. Kenneth M. Curtis in 1969. As a judge-at-large, he presided in every district court in the state.

Earlier, he had served as a municipal court judge, having been appointed by then-Gov. Edmund S. Muskie in 1958, and prior to that time had practiced law in Biddeford with his brother, Louis Spill.

He was a member of the Maine and Massachusetts bars and was admitted to practice before the U.S. Supreme Court in Washington, D.C.

The son of Abraham and Rebecca Spill, he was born on Dec. 25, 1908 in Biddeford. He graduated from the Biddeford schools and the Boston University College of Liberal Arts. He received his law degree cum laude from the Boston University School of Law and in 1982 was awarded an honorary doctorate of jurisprudence from that school.

A lifelong Democrat, Judge Spill was active in

local, county and state politics throughout his career. He served as solicitor for the city of Biddeford for many years. He also was a trustee at the McArthur Library in Biddeford and a board member and former director at Southern Maine Medical Center in Biddeford, formerly Webber Hospital.

He was a past president of the York County Bar Association, Saco-Biddeford Kiwanis Club and the B'nai B'rith of Biddeford. He was member of the Biddeford Elks and the Shriners Club in Portland. He also was past president and a member of the congregation at Etz Chaim Synagogue of Biddeford and a member of Temple Beth El of Portland.

Judge Spill is survived by his wife of 53 years, Esther M.; two daughters, Carole Spill Berman of Auburn and Boston and Linda R. Cooley of Sharon, Mass.; and five grandchildren.

BOOTHBAY HARBOR - Dewey Artemus Spofford, 95, one of the town's first mechanics and the longtime owner of Spofford's Service Station, died Wednesday at the Gregory Wing nursing facility.

For 25 years Mr. Spofford ran his small repair shop on Route 27 in Boothbay, just north of Adams Pond. Before

that he had been a machinist at Sample's Shipyard, a blacksmith, and a seaman.

Although deaf, Mr. Spofford was an expert mechanic who could tune car engines by his sense of touch. "He'd put his fingers on the block, and tell if it was running just right," said his son, Ronald E. Spofford.

"He could even sense a knock sometimes," said another son, Gordon C. Spofford.

He returned to Boothbay Harbor in about 1920 and began working as an automobile mechanic. At first he also did blacksmithing and repaired wagons.

From 1938 to 1941, he was co-owner of Central Garage, which sold and repaired Fords.

During World War II, Mr. Spofford was a foreman machinist at Sample's Shipyard here, and supervised installation of steam engines on tugs. He started Spofford's Service Station on Route 27 after the war.

Mr. Spofford was described by his sons as a very hard worker. He lived many years in a house on Barter's Island that he built by himself. "He wired and plumbed it and dug the cellar with a spade," said Gordon. "He hauled out the stumps with an old Buick. Work never bothered him."

During the 1950s, Mr. Spofford built Spofford's Dairy Freeze next door to the garage. He also helped his wife, Eleanor Greenleaf Spofford, operate the business.

Born here, he was a son of Hiram A. and Margaret Crooks Spofford.

Mrs. Spofford died in 1978, and he lived in Florida for a while with his granddaughter, Diane Randlett.

He enjoyed chair caning, gardening, wood crafts and travel. At age 90, he went to Liscomb, Nova Scotia, to research his roots and see his grandfather's grave.

He was a 50-year-plus member of the Bayview Masonic Lodge.

Surviving are his two sons, both of Boothbay Harbor; and five grandchildren.
