OWLS HEAD – George F. Sprague, 85, of Owls Head died Tuesday at his home here.

Born at Drew Plantation, a son of Marion Everett and Maude Scott Sprague, he attended Danforth schools, worked his way through Colby College and graduated in 1931.

He was a debater, a weight thrower and the wearer of the Intercollegiate Stripe. At one time he held the school record in the 16-pound hammer throw.

For two years, Mr. Sprague taught and coached at Lee Academy, then worked eight years in Maine for Curtis Publishing Co. He was then promoted to a home office position in Philadelphia. After four years there he spent 25 years with Reader's Digest in Pleasantville, N.Y., where he was a vice president and a director.

He was a 14-year trustee of Knox Hospital and its successor, Pen Bay Medical Center, where he was chairman of the investment committee for 12 years.

He also served on the Lee Academy board of trustees for 10 years and was investment committee chairman. During that period he also served a term as chairman of the board.

He was a 52-year member of the Aurora Masonic Lodge, and a past president of the Mount Kisco Lions Club and the Mount Kisco Boys Club.

His wife, Lillias Reed Sprague, died in 1991.

Surviving are a son, Christopher; two brothers, Robert of Bangor and Donald of Avon, Conn.; a sister, Amy of Needham, Mass.; two grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
