Robert A. Sproul Sr., 71, Walpole, of Bay Ridge Farm, died May 13 at his residence. He was born in South Bristol November 2, 1919, a son of Austin V. and Doris (Seavey) Sproul. He attended South Bristol Schools, graduating Salutatorian from South Bristol High School.

Following his marriage to the former Constance Jones, in 1938, Mr. Sproul became self employed as both a dairy and poultry farmer, working his farm over 50 years. For 46 years, he delivered milk throughout Bristol and South Bristol, as well growing and selling vegetables, and shipping butter to several parts of the country. He still maintained a few head of cattle after retiring in 1988. He was a member and past master of the Anchor Lodge of Masons, in South Bristol, for 48 years.

The Rev. Charles William Squires, DD, 75, of 40 Winter Street, pastor of the Baptist Church in Limerick since 1934, died late this forenoon in the Mercy Hospital.

Jr. and his wife Pamela of Auburn; one brother, Howard of Houlton; eight grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; and two great-great-granddaughters; one niece, Gail Thiboutot of Brunswick; and three nephews.

He was predeceased by two sisters, Madelyn Stacey and Marion Couture.
