Brunswick, Feb. 11—Dr. Albert H. Staples, 61, Brunswick's only dental surgeon, died today at the Veterans' Hospital, Togus, following a two months' illness. A native of Brunswick, he was born Feb. 5, 1883, the son of Josiah H., and Frances Ellen Potter Staples. He was graduated from Brunswick High School and what is now the University of Pennsylvania Dental School. He practised for a while at Norway. Before coming to Brunswick approximately 35 years ago. In 1912 he married Alice Eaton, who survives him. He is also survived by one son, First Lt. Josiah H. Staples in the Army, a brother, George Staples of Portland, and a sister, Mrs. Mabel O'Brien of Hollywood.

Dr. Staples served in the Army Medical Corps during World War One and held a commission of major in the Army Reserve. He belonged to the Masons, was a past commander of the George T. Files Legion Post, a member of the Maine Dental Society, and for many years served as clerk of course at the Topsham Fair races.

### CHESTER HENRY STAPLES

BELMONT - Chester H. Staples, 79, died May 13, 2004 at Shore Village Rehabilitation and Nursing Center in Rockland. He was born April 13, 1925, in Belmont, the son of George W. and Florence G. (Flagg) Staples.

At age 17, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy, serving in World War II. He was a 25-year member of the Excelsior Lodge #151 in Northport. He was also a 57-year member of the American Legion, Post #43 of Belfast. He was employed by Chaplin Motors in Portland, ME as a master mechanic for 10 years, raised broiler chickens for Maplewood Poultry in Belfast for 10 years. He worked 20 years part-time at the docks in Searsport for the Jarka Corp. and worked for State Sand and Gravel in Belfast as a cement truck driver for 26 years.

Chet was a people-person. He was always ready to lend a helping hand to a neighbor, a friend, or even a stranger in need. Biddeford, Nov. 29—Lytton E. Staples, 66, vice president of the Biddeford Savings Bank and formerly treasurer of that institution for a long period, died late today at his home, 8 Green Street, following an illness of several months.

He was a native of this city, the son of Edward W. and Clara Frisbie Stables, his father having served as mayor of the city and also as treasurer of the savings bank. Soon after his graduation from Biddeford High School, he entered the employ of the bank learning the business, and on the death of his father succeeded him as treasurer.
