## Ercell Harry Steward

BINGHAM — Ercell Harry Steward, 78, died Friday, Oct. 18, at his home in Bingham.

LISBON FALLS — Otto Stewich, 85, of 13 Berry Ave., died Sunday, March 25, 1990, at a Lewiston hospital. He distinguished himself during America's World War II effort by finding ways to make carding machines that produced woolen goods for Navy uniforms at twice the normal capacity.

Born in Berlin, Germany, June 12, 1904, he was the son of Max Wilhelm and Wilhelmine Voelker Stewich. He grew up in Grunburg, Slesia, now Zalona Gora, Poland. Following graduation from the Technische Hochschule in Cottbus, he worked in woolen mills in Germany and Romania.

In 1930 he was recruited by the owners of the Worumbo Mill in Lisbon Falls and came to America to be their overseer of carding.

He remained in America and in 1935, married Madlyn Risska. She died in 1976.

Mr. Stewich was active in town affairs and was a member of Ancient York Lodge, AF&AM; the Ancient Accepted Scottish Rites, Valley of Lewiston and Auburn; the Kora Temple, Androscoggin Shrine Club; the Lisbon Falls Library Association; the Lisbon Senior Citizens and was the last Oberbarter of Lisbon's well-known German Lodge.

He was also a committeeman and treasurer of Troop 109 Boy Scouts of America in Lisbon Falls for many years.

Surviving him are a son, Bill Stewich of Chelmsford, Mass.; a sister, Emma Stewich of Nuremberg, Germany; and two grandchildren.

Joseph S. Stickney, 62, of Saco, for the last six years director of Maine's Wild Life Research Division and previously supervisor for 11 years of Inland Fisheries and Game Department wardens in Southern Maine, died Sunday in the Mercy Hospital following an illness of several months.

Mr. Stickney, one of the most widely-known authorities on fish and game in New England, was born in Portland, son of Mr. and Mrs. Henry R. 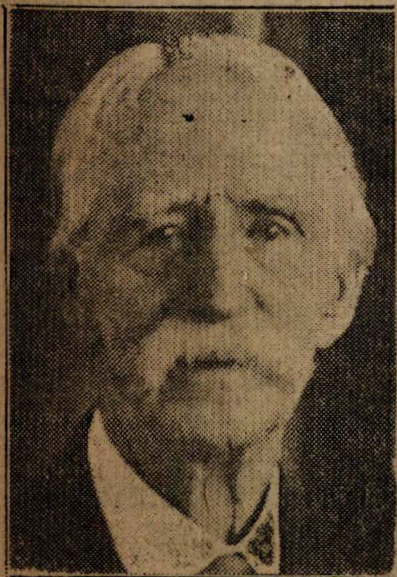

Allan Prescott Stevens, 63, auditor of the Chisos Mining Company of which Howard E. Perry is president, and one of Portland's most prominent business men, died Monday night at the Maine General Hospital, following several days' illness having been a patient in the hospital since Sept. 3.

Born at Brockton, Mass., son of the late Rev. Henry A. Stevens he had made his home in Portland for the past 19 years and for the past nine years had maintained a summer home at Buxton Lower Corner. His

He was predeceased by his brother, Merle, who was an Army veteran from the Korean War. He is survived by his wife, Lois (Burns) Stevens; sons, Ronald and his family, of Norway, and Edward and his wife, of North Hampton, N.H.; a sister, Ellen Schroeder of Westport Island; and several nieces and nephews.
