LISBON FALLS — Otto Stewich, 85, of 13 Berry Ave., died Sunday, March 25, 1990, at a Lewiston hospital. He distinguished himself during America's World War II effort by finding ways to make carding machines that produced woolen goods for Navy uniforms at twice the normal capacity.

He remained in America and in 1935, married Madlyn Risska. She died in 1976.

Mr. Stewich was active in town affairs and was a member of Ancient York Lodge, AF&AM; the Ancient Accepted Scottish Rites, Valley of Lewiston and Auburn; the Kora Temple, Androscoggin Shrine Club; the Lisbon Falls Library Association; the Lisbon Senior Citizens and was the last Oberbarter of Lisbon's well-known German Lodge.

He was also a committeeman and treasurer of Troop 109 Boy Scouts of America in Lisbon Falls for many years.

Surviving him are a son, Bill Stewich of Chelmsford, Mass.; a sister, Emma Stewich of Nuremberg, Germany; and two grandchildren.

Joseph S. Stickney, 62, of Saco, for the last six years director of Maine's Wild Life Research Division and previously supervisor for 11 years of Inland Fisheries and Game Department wardens in Southern Maine, died Sunday in the Mercy Hospital following an illness of several months.





Charles H. Stevens, 88, of George Street, retired in 1931 as chief operator of the local Western Union Telegraph Company office after 55 years of service, died Wednesday afternoon in a local hospital, to which he was taken Saturday.

A native of Somersworth, then Great Falls, N. H., he came to Portland with his parents in 1873, his father, George W. Stevens, being an engineer on the Boston and Maine Railroad. He took up telegraphy in the old signal house of the Boston and Maine at the foot of Danforth Street and the following year returned to Somersworth to take a position with the company.

Returning to Portland in 1881, he went to work for the American Union Telegraph Company, which later purchased the Western Union. From then until his retirement he was at the Exchange Street office and later in the Monument Square office. He was at Portsmouth, N. H., during the Russo-Japanese Peace Conference.

He was a 32nd degree Mason and holder of the first 50-year Masonic Medal presented in this State. The medal was designed by a son, the late Walter H. H. Stevens of Mineola, Long Island, N. Y. He was also a member of the Odd Fellows, Knights of Pythias, Red Men, Modern Woodmen and New England Order of Protection and a former member of Portland Lodge of Elks.
