## Richard W. Stillings

### distinguished military, public service career

BERWICK - Retired Col. Richard W. Stillings, the first chief of staff for the 804th Hospital Center, Army Reserve at Hanscom Air Force Base, Mass., from 1982 until his retirement, died Sunday. He was 67 and resided on Sullivan Street.

He was born in Berwick, a son of Maurice B. and Doris Allen Stillings. He attended local schools and was a graduate of the University of Maine at Orono.

Col. Stillings served as an enlisted man in the Army in Germany from 1946 to 1948. He was commissioned a 2nd lieutenant in 1951 and was the distinguished military graduate on his graduation from the University of Maine in 1952.

Following graduation he served with the 60th Infantry Regiment, 9th Division at Fort Dix, N.J., and with Company G, 223rd Infantry Regiment, 40th Division in Korea during the Korean War. He commanded the unit defending Heartbreak Ridge at the time of the truce.

After release from active duty he served in Army Reserve assignments, including platoon leader and company commander in the Military Police Corps, company commander and battalion operations officer in the Transportation Corps, commander of a medical battalion and a medical group, general staff positions with the 94th Army Reserve Command, and commander of the 1125th Army Hospital in Auburn.

Col. Stillings ended his 38-year military career as the first chief of staff of the 804th Army Hospital Center at Hanscom Air Force Base in Bedford, Mass.

General Staff College, graduating on the Commandant's List. Overseas service included tours of duty in Germany, Japan, Korea and the United Kingdom.

He was an honors graduate of the Institute for Organization Management at Syracuse University.

From 1958 to 1971 he served as chief of the Berwick Police Department. He was director of civil defense and public safety and president of the Berwick Health Council. He was the moderator of Berwick's town meeting for 27 years.

He represented Acton, Lebanon and Berwick for three terms in the Maine House of Representatives. During that time he was selected as Outstanding Public Official of 1973 by the Maine State Employees Associa-

tion. In 1972 he received the Maine Highway Safety Committee Award for his legislative work on highway safety. He represented Maine at the 1973 National Conference on Criminal Justice and served as a member of the Republican State Committee.

He was executive director of the Greater Somersworth Chamber of Commerce from 1958 to 1961. He was chairman of the Berwick Planning Board from 1965 through 1971 and again from 1979 through 1981. He was Berwick's town planner from 1989 to 1991. He was a founding member and past president of the Berwick Historical Society and an honorary member of the Berwick Library Association Board of Directors. He was president of the Committee for the Bicentennial of the American Revolution and president of the Bicentennial of the US Constitution Committee of Berwick.

He was Berwick's Citizen of the Year in 1989 and was grand marshal of the 1994 Christmas parade. He was a member of the Co-operative Alliance for Seacoast Transportation Board of Directors, a trustee of the Berwick Cemetery Association and chairman of the Berwick Sewer District Board of Trustees.

He was a past commander, past chaplain and historian of Charles S. Hatch Post #79 American Legion and a member of Berwick-North Berwick Memorial Post #1089, Veterans of Foreign Wars.

He was a past chancellor commander of Rathbone Lodge and past deputy grand chancellor of the Grand Lodge of Maine, Knights of Pythias and a past president of South Berwick Rotary Club. He was past president of Sullivan-Berwick Alumni Association. He was a member of St. John's Lodge #51 AF&AM, and was a member of the Association of the United States Army, the Reserve Officers Association and the Society for Military History.

He is survived by a brother, Robert L. of Waldoboro, two sisters, Marjorie S. Dugas of Manchester, N.H., and Sheila M. Moody of Groton, Mass.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday at the United Methodist Church of Berwick. The Revs. Joan Ann Westfall and Wayne Nelson will officiate. Burial will be in Evergreen Cemetery, Berwick, in the spring. Arrangements are by Laing Funeral Chapel, Berwick.
