LIVERMORE FALLS, May 8 (Special)—Chester Houghton Sturtevant, 78, manager and treasurer of the Livermore Falls Trust Company for 49 years and since 1927 its president, died Sunday.

A native of Fayette, he graduated from Kents Hill Seminary in 1888 and received his AB degree from Colby College in 1892. He was principal of Madison High School from 1892 to 1893 and then came here to study law. He afterwards went to Portland to study the banking business and in 1895 organized the Livermore Falls Trust Company.

He had served as Representative to the State Legislature three terms, was a member of the board of trustees of Colby College, member of the State Convention Board of the United Baptist Convention of Maine and a deacon and chorister at the First Baptist Church.

He was also a trustee of Oriental Star Lodge, F. and A. M., president of the Livermore Falls Library Association, treasurer of the Livermore Falls Cemetery Association and GAR Memorial Hall Association, past commander of Munset Camp, Sons of Union Veterans, and past patron of Washburn Chapter, OES.
