**YORK BEACH —** Norris A. Talpey, 85, of Route 1A and Sidney, Ohio, for many years the town clerk and tax collector for the town of York, died Friday at a Maumee, Ohio, hospital after a long illness.

He was born in York, the son of Albert J. and Helen Tuttlefield Talpey. He graduated from York High School and attended the University of New Hampshire.

## K. Nestor Tamminen

gem collector, prospector and miner

WEST PARIS - K. Nestor Tamminen, 94, an internationally-known gem collector, died Tuesday at the Ledgeview Nursing Home in West Paris.

Mr. Tamminen mined the Tamminen, Wausen and BB#7 quarries commercially for feldspar and mica at various times. He engaged in prospecting until his health failed.

### PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or on the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

He enjoyed sitting on his front porch and chatting with visitors who would come to see his collection or ask to go up to the mine on his property. "He's had people from every state ... people from almost every nation stop by," said a daughter, Patricia Verrill. "He loved to talk with people and share where things had been found," she said.

He would often swap minerals with people that came to visit.

Another daughter, Elizabeth Hayes, called it a "gentlemen's agreement."

"If you came to him with a mineral he didn't have ... they'd swap," she said.

Mr. Tamminen loved to joke with people that came to ask about going to the mine. Hayes said people would always ask, "Can I go up to the mine?" and his response would be, "Well, I don't know if you can, but you may."

"He was always a kiddier like that," she said.

Also on his front porch was a poster that read, "Let There Be Peace on Earth and Let it Begin With Me."

"He had that (poster) for years - he believed in it," said Hayes. "That was his motto."

Mr. Tamminen was a recent recipient of the Boston Post Cane as the oldest Greenwood resident.

He was born in Hinnerjoki, Finland, the eldest son of Kusti Richard Tamminen and Holmi Alexandra Silander. He immigrated to the United States with his mother and brother in 1910, joining his father who was already here.

Mr. Tamminen attended schools in Fitchburg, Mass. He moved to Maine in 1920. As a young man he played baseball in the Pine Tree League, pitching for Locke Mills.

He married Katie Kakkonen in 1929. They settled on a farm in Greenwood and celebrated 65 years of marriage together.

Mr. Tamminen had a varied career. He had a radio dealership and assembled radios, farmed, raised poultry, ran logging camps and was the manager of the National Co-op store in West Paris for many years.

Mr. Tamminen served Greenwood as first selectman for 19 years and as constable for 20. He was also on the board of directors of the Extension Service.

He was a 55-year member of the West Paris Grangewas very active, a 50-year member of Granite Masonic Lodge of West Paris, and was a charter member of the Finnish-American Heritage Society and a member of the Oxford County Gem and Mineral Society.

His special friends included Arvve Tarvenpass and sister-in-law Evelyn Tamminen.

Surviving are three daughters, Elizabeth Hayes and Patricia Verrill, both of Norway, and Mary Perham of Greenwood; six grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; and two great-great-grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. Sunday at the Raymond/Weston-Chandler Funeral Home, 119 Main St., Norway. There will be no visitation.

Mr. Tanner also enjoyed traveling. His wife said they went to Spain, Portugal and Hawaii on their own, and also went to Aruba and Barbados with other Shriners. ## Roland Alvah Tarbox

### World War II veteran, worked for FBI

WISCASSET - Roland Alvah Tarbox, 74, of Federal Street died Monday at his home of malignant mesothelioma.

He was born in Buffalo, N.Y., a son of Henry Arthur and Martha Skagen Tarbox. He attended Wiscasset schools and graduated from Wiscasset Academy in 1939. He also graduated from Merchant Marine Academy, Kings Point, N.Y., in 1943. During World War II, Mr. Tarbox served in the Navy as a combat submarine officer in the Pacific Theater.

He was a founding partner with J. Kenneth Lincoln of KENRO Chevrolet in Damariscotta, which was sold to Strong Chevrolet in 1956. He entered the Federal Bureau of Investigation in 1956 and also worked for the Defense Investigative Service and Naval Investigative Service, his son John said.

His father loved Maine, John Tarbox said, but like many in the 1950s, he had to leave the state to find opportunity.

"He loved Maine, and he was sort of torn. He loved the small-town life, but he wanted the challenge," his son said.

#### PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

The family moved often while Mr. Tarbox worked for the government. He was often away for long stretches and the family would never learn much about his days because of the nature of his work.

"He was always very closemouthed about the whole thing," John Tarbox said. "If your dad's a fireman, you go down to the fire station and have an idea of what he does for a job. He worked for the government and dealt with top secret material. But he felt the work he was doing was very valuable."

After Mr. Tarbox retired from the government in 1979, he was able to return to Maine, settling in Wiscasset.

His family has strong ties to Maine, tracing its lineage back to Cornelius Tarbox, one of the original settlers of Westport Island.

John Tarbox said that in his retirement, his father was very outgoing and involved in a variety of civic groups, including the Wiscasset Fire Society.

Mr. Tarbox often traveled the state and was particularly drawn to the ocean, John Tarbox said.

"They would always drive down to a different place in Maine and see the different towns and go to the restaurants," he said. One favorite was the mailboat run to Monhegan Island, John Tarbox said.

Mr. Tarbox was a member of the Lincoln Lodge, a 32nd degree mason, a member of Kora Temple of the Shrine, and the First Congregational Church.

Surviving are his wife of 50 years, Pearl "Choppie" Lockerby Tarbox of Wiscasset; two sons, John Skagen Tarbox of Wiscasset and Karl Frederick Tarbox, who is with the Peace Corps in Uzbekistan; and two granddaughters, Abigail and Katherine Tarbox, both of New Canaan, Conn.
