His father loved Maine, John Tarbox said, but like many in the 1950s, he had to leave the state to find opportunity.

"He loved Maine, and he was sort of torn. He loved the small-town life, but he wanted the challenge," his son said. The family moved often while Mr. Tarbox worked for the government. He was often away for long stretches and the family would never learn much about his days because of the nature of his work.

"He was always very closemouthed about the whole thing." John Tarbox said. "If your dad's a fireman, you go down to the fire station and have an idea of what he does for a job. He worked for the government and dealt with top secret material. But he felt the work he was doing was very valuable."

After Mr. Tarbox retired from the government in 1979, he was able to return to Maine, settling in Wiscasset.

His family has strong ties to Maine, tracing its lineage back to Cornelius Tarbox, one of the original settlers of Westport Island.

John Tarbox said that in his retirement, his father was very outgoing and involved in a variety of civic groups, including the Wiscasset Fire Society.

Mr. Tarbox often traveled the state and was particularly drawn to the ocean, John Tarbox said.

"They would always drive down to a different place in Maine and see the different towns and go to the restaurants," he said. One favorite was the mailboat run to Monhegan Island, John Tarbox said.

Mr. Tarbox was a member of the Lincoln Lodge, a 32nd degree mason, a member of Kora Temple of the Shrine, and the First Congregational Church.

Surviving are his wife of 50 years, Pearl "Choppie" Lockerby Tarbox of Wiscasset; two sons, John Skagen Tarbox of Wiscasset and Kard Frederick Tarbox, who is with the Peace Corps in Uzbekistan; and two grand-daughters, Abigail and Katherine Tarbox, both of New Canaan Com.






