AUGUSTA— John W. Tarr, 88, son of John L. Tarr and Elsie (Lovejoy) Tarr, passed away peacefully at the Maine Veterans Home in Augusta on Feb. 6, 2006.



Born in Anson, June 15, 1917, he graduated from Madison High School, Hebron Academy and Colby College. He served in the Army during World War II, from August 1942 to January 1946.

Following that, he attended graduate schools at the University of Pennsylvania and Boston University, where he received a master's degree.

In 1945, he married his wife of 60 years, Priscilla (Huff) Tarr. For 30 years he was employed at the VA Center, Togus, first as a counseling psychologist and then as chief of the counseling and rehabilitation section.

Curtis C. Taylor Jr.

Lyman town official, dairy farmer

LYMAN - Curtis C. Taylor Jr., 75, a former selectman and a longtime dairy farmer, died Friday in a Biddeford hospital after a long illness.

Mr. Taylor was well known in town, often serving as moderator at the annual town meeting. He was elected to a three-year term as selectman in 1968, and was an appointed and elected member of the town's budget committee.

PASSAGES

Mr. Taylor served as the town's deputy fire warden in 1964. He later worked as a member of the Forestry Committee and the Appeals Board.

While serving the town, Mr. Taylor ran the family dairy farm.

"My dad was one of the first to get involved in the proper ways of rotating crops - growing different things on different fields at different intervals - in order to control erosion," his son said.

In 1945, the Taylor Farm became a cooperator with the York County Soil and Water Conservation District.

Mr. Taylor was an active volunteer with the district, serving as a district supervisor in 1965, chairman of the board of supervisors from 1969 to 1973 and chairman of the Maine Association of Conservation District in 1973.

In 1976, the Taylors were named Maine's Farm Family of the Year by the Farmers Home Administration.

Mr. Taylor was an active member of the American Legion, Arion Masonic Lodge of Lyman and the Order of the Eastern Star. He also was a member of the Maine Farm Bureau, Cooperative Extension Service, the York County Soil and Water Conservation District, and the Lyman Rock Snowmobile Club.

Mr. Taylor was born on the family farm, a son of Curtis C. and Delia Drew Taylor, and attended Alfred High School.

During World War II, Mr. Taylor served in the Army as a heavy machine gunner in France and Germany.

Surviving are his wife of 53 years, Dorothy Gray Taylor; a son, Michael C. of Lyman; a daughter, Janet Janus of Lyman; four sisters, Celeste Kimball of South Carolina, Claire Scammon of East Waterboro, K. Jo Drown of Hudson, N.H., and Marilyn Flagg of Jefferson; and five grandchildren.
