CAMDEN, Aug. 30—John L. Tewksbury, 71, prominent in civic and Masonic affairs, died today. He had been assistant cashier of Camden National Bank from 1923 until his retirement recently for ill health.

He was a past grand commander of Camden Commandery, a member of Maine Council of High Priests, Maine Chapter No. 1, Past Officers Association, chairman of the board of trustees of the charity fund of Amity Lodge, chairman of the finance committee of Keystone chapter, and director, treasurer and manager of the Camden Masonic Temple Association. He was district deputy grand master of the Ninth Masonic District in 1927 and 1928 and was grand senior warden of the Grand Lodge of Maine in 1936, and grand scribe in 1930 of Grand Royal Arch Chapter of Maine.
