Alden M. Tibbetts, 77, of Sedgwick and Sarasota, Fla., a retired maritime executive, died April 15 at Sarasota.

Born May 26, 1918, in Melrose, Mass., Tibbetts graduated with honors from Massachusetts Maritime Academy in 1939. He joined the Grace Lines after graduation, and served as third and second mate on cargo and passenger ships on the South America run.

When the United States entered World War II, Tibbetts was recruited by Pan American Airways as a navigator and navigational instructor in the "old flying boats" to Lisbon, Portugal. Later he served in the Ferry Command where he was responsible for plotting most of the air routes across Africa and the Far East. After the war he was named chief navigator for Pan Am, serving that airline until 1947.

From 1947 to 1949 Tibbetts worked with his father in a Boston insurance firm, then opened his own air and marine insurance agency in Florida. In 1958, he was elected president of Parker and Co., a national marine and aviation insurance underwriting firm. He joined Aegis Corp. as vice president of administration in 1969, and later was promoted to senior vice president with responsibility for the firm's Savannah Ship and Foundry Co. and Wellcraft Boat Works, a small-boat manufacturing company.

A member of the Board of Visitors of Massachusetts Maritime Academy, Tibbetts was active throughout his life in the academy's alumni affairs, and was given special recognition as the "Outstanding Alumnus for 1975."

While living in Florida, Tibbetts was active in Rotary International and the National Propeller Club, and was an enthusiastic yachtsman: member of two Miami yacht clubs and sailing on the Southern racing circuit. After retiring to a new home in Sedgwick, he joined the Ellsworth Rotary Club and the First Congregational Church of Blue Hill.

He is survived by his wife, Jerry (Kenniston) Tibbetts; a son, Rod Tibbetts of Bradenton, Fla.; three daughters, Martha Voyles and Nancy Stevens, both of Sarasota, and Diane Bye of Charleston, S.C.; a brother, Norman Tibbetts of St. Petersburg, Fla.; eight grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

A memorial service was held yesterday, April 17, 1996, at the First Presbyterian Church, Sarasota. A memorial service will be held in Blue Hill at a later date. Contributions in Alden's memory may be made to Four Town Nursing Service or Peninsula Ambulance Corps, both of Blue Hill.

Dr. Edward A. Tibbetts, 89, a caring, devoted osteopathic physician for more than 50 years, died Friday at his Woodford Street home.

Dr. Tibbetts was associated with the Osteopathic Hospital of Maine - now Brighton Medical Center - for half a century and ran a solo practice from his home office for many years before retiring in 1994.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

"He just loved what he was doing," said Averil Laffin Tibbetts of Portland, his wife of 45 years. "His patients kept saying, 'Please don't retire, please don't retire.' That's one reason he kept at it so long. He cared a great deal for his patients."

He was born in East Hampton, Mass., a son of

George F. and Mathilda Letendre Tibbetts, attended high school in Thorndike, Mass., and graduated from Cushing Academy in Ashburnham, Mass.

He was employed by Finger Lakes State Parks Commission in Ithaca, N.Y., and by All-Tech Corporation in Philadelphia.

He later graduated from the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine.

Dr. Tibbetts interned at Baker Hospital in Lancaster, Pa. In the early 1940s, he was the team physician for the Philadelphia Eagles one year and the Pittsburgh Steelers the next.

"He attended all the games and traveled with the teams," his wife said. "He was a big football fan, so it was a real thrill for him."

He also had a general practice in Pennsylvania for four years before moving to Portland.

He was an anesthesiologist at the Osteopathic Hospital of Maine, now Brighton Medical Center, for 25 years, and was a staff member for 50 years.

He retired from the hospital in 1974 and resumed his solo practice.

He worked side by side with his wife, the office's secretary and bookkeeper. He devoted his practice to osteopathic manipulation.

"He had a very good bedside manner and a wonderful sense of humor," she said. "To me, he was quite a perfect guy."

Dr. Tibbetts was a member of the Cumberland County Osteopathic Society, and a life member of the Maine Osteopathic Association, the American Osteopathic Association and the American College of Anesthesiologists. He was also a member of the New England Academy of Osteopathy, New England Osteopathic Assembly, Diplomate of the National Board of Examiners.

He was a member of the Woodfords Club, Hiram Lodge of Masons, Kora Temple Shrine, Kora Shrine Club, Maine Historical Society, Maine Old Cemeteries Association and Strawberry Banke. He was a former member of the Exchange Club, Deering Lions Club, National Rifle Association and New England Genealogical Society.

His interests included photography, the Boston Red Sox and genealogy. He traced his family's roots to 1635, his wife said.

A daughter, Adrienne Tibbetts, died in 1974.

Surviving besides his wife is a sister, Pheobe Winch of West Brookfield, Mass.

There will be no visiting hours. A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at Jones, Rich and Hutchins Funeral Home, 199 Woodford St., with the Rev. Dr. Karl S. Andersen officiating.

George A. Tibbetts, 61, a member for 25 years of the staff of the Maine General Hospital, Portland, died suddenly early tonight in his home, 28 Danforth Road.

Dr. Tibbetts resigned from the attending staff of the Maine General Hospital in 1946 and since had served as a member of the consulting staff.

Dover-Foxcroft, Nov. 10.—George E. Tebbetts, 89, a Civil War veteran, and vice commander of the local G. A. R. post, died Monday at the home of his daughter, Mrs. O. T. Caswell with whom he has made his home since the death of his wife three years ago.

Mr. Tebbetts, a native of Hermon, saw four years' service in the war between the North and the South. His services included three weeks under fire in dug-outs and gopher holes before Petersburg, fighting at Spottsylvania, and other battles.
