Saco, Jan. 11—James Edward Towle, 69, a former chief of the Saco fire department, and for more than 20 years foreman of the paint department at the Saco-Lowell shops, Biddeford, died in a Biddeford hospital today.

He was born in Saco, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Ivory H. Towle, was educated in the local schools and after leaving school entered the employ of his father who conducted a large carriage-manufacturing and paint shop on Scammon Street. At the death of his father several years ago he conducted the business for some years before disposing of it to enter the employ of the Saco-Lowell Company. He was a member and captain of the Governor Fairfield company of the Saco fire department before becoming chief engineer in 1913. He was a member of the Saco lodge of Masons and the United Baptist Church.

Survivors are two sons, Charles S. and Ivory H. Towle, and a daughter, P. Elizabeth Deasey, all of Saco.
