Barber

KEZAR FALLS — Winslow E. Townsend, 87, of the Federal Road, died this morning at a Portland nursing home.

He was born in Limerick, son of Frank and Etta Bisby Townsend, and attended Limerick schools and Thornton Academy, Saco.
