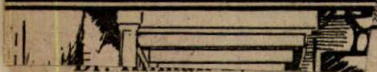

The Rev. Olin Hobbs Tracy, D. D., 87, fourth generation in a family of ministers, who has been making his home with his son, Rev. Olin B. Tracy, pastor of the First Congregational Church, 119 West Foster Street, Melrose, Mass., passed away Aug. 7.

Dr. Tracy was stricken on his birthday, July 4, prior to which time he had been active. He was the son of Ferdinand Tracy and Sylvia Jane Hobbs, and was born in Auburn. He was graduated from Bates College in 1882 and Cobb Divinity School in 1885, receiving his degree as Doctor of Divinity later from Hillsdale College, Mich.

Ordained as a Baptist minister in 1885, Dr. Tracy served as a pastor of a Congregational Church in Strong, while attending college. His next pastorate was in Biddeford. His first wife, Susie E. Barbaric, died while he was pastor in Oakland, Calif., in 1884. Then for seven years

he was State Supt. of churches of the Free Baptist denomination for the state of Minnesota, making his headquarters in Minneapolis.

From there he went to Somersworth, N. H. July 4, 1896, he was married to his second wife, Etta Gertrude Goodwin of Oakland, who later became the first ordained woman minister in Maine, and one of the earliest in New England.

He then began his ministry in Boston, at the First Free Baptist Church, then located at Shawmut Ave., corner of Rutland Street. This building was sold to Tufts College, and property bought in Roxbury, where a new church was erected on Warren Street.

In this pastorate he followed the Rev. John Loudon, D. D., who had come from the First Free Baptist Church of Portland, and he was succeeded by the Rev. J. Stanley Durkee, D. D., later of the famous Plymouth Church, Brooklyn, N. Y.

Following his Boston pastorate he had school churches at Maine Central Institute, Pittsfield, and the New Hampton School for boys, New Hamp-

ton, N. H. He later federated the Free Baptist and the Congregational Church at Skowhegan and also held pastorates at Shelton, Conn., North Deering, South Paris, Cornish, South Portland and Brownville, at which latter place he retired 10 years ago to make his home with his sons.

He was a Mason, an Odd Fellow, a member of the Maccabees, and the Grange. He leaves two sons, Rev. Olin B. Tracy, pastor of the First Congregational Church, Melrose, and Leighton G. Tracy, New York district manager for the Berger Division of the Republic Steel Corporation. The Leighton Tracys live in Pelham, N. Y., and have two children, a son, Carll Knapp Tracy, and a daughter Gloria Leigh Tracy. Dr. Tracy also leaves a nephew, Ralph L. Millett, of Memphis, Tenn.

The funeral services were held from the First Congregational Church, Melrose, Wednesday, Aug. 9, the Rev. Rodney W. Roundy, Supt. of the Congregational Christian Conference of Maine, officiating. Burial was in Mt. Auburn Cemetery, Auburn, Me.

James A. Trafton, 87, retired Westbrook horse dealer and one of the oldest residents of that city, died today in his home, 458 Main Street, in that city. He had been ill several weeks.
