



DR. ARTHUR TRAYFORD

Dr. Arthur Trayford, DVM, 88, Waldoboro, died Nov. 28, at a Rockport Hospital.

He was born in Hazel Grove, Cheshire County, England a son of Charles II and Beatrice Ann Sacker Trayford. he moved to the United States when he was 3 and attended schools in Huntington, Long Island.

He worked his way through Cornell University, were he was a soloist with the glee club and a star long-distance runner on the track team, and graduated at the top of his class, Phi Beta Kappa in 1927.

He practiced veterinary medicine and surgery, and in 1932 purchased his own practice, the Fort Hill Animal Hospital.

After retiring in 1965 he moved to Birch Grove Farm in Waldoboro with his wife, Winona Harris Trayford.

While in Huntington, he was president of the Veterinary Medical Association and was a member of the executive board of the New York State Veterinary Medical Society for 13 years.

He also received a plaque of honor from the New York Board of Veterinary Medicine. He was the first to use Stader splints for animals, later used by orthopedic surgeons for people.

He was an elder of the Old First Presbyterian Church in Huntington, a member of the Huntington Rotary Club for many years, a member of the Long Island Early Fliers Club and the Air Craft Owners and Pilot Association.

He was a lecturer at Cornell and co-wrote a book, "McCall's Complete Family Guide to Puppy and Dog Care."

He was a member of King Solomons Lodge, Waldoboro, the Waldoboro Lions Club, and the United Methodist Church. jo wife (
