WESTBROOK — Norman Emerson Trafton, 65, of 458 Main St., died suddenly yesterday in a Portland hospital. He had been stricken ill a short time before in Trafton's Shoe Store, of which he was proprietor.

Mr. Trafton had been treasurer of the Westbrook Parking Authority since it was created in 1957.

He was born in Westbrook Dec. 3, 1897, son of Ella Merserve Trafton of Westbrook and the late Otis Trafton.

He was graduated from Hebron Academy in 1917 and attended the Marion Institute, Marion, Ala., and the University of Maine, where he was a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon Fraternity.

In 1922 he joined the W. T. Grant Co. and served the firm in various stores all over the United States. In 1946 he returned to Westbrook, where he succeeded his father as a shoe retailer.

Mr. Trafton was treasurer of the Westbrook Parking Authority, a member of Warren-Phillips Lodge AF&AM, a 32nd degree Scottish Rite Mason, and a member of Kora Shrine Temple, Lewiston. He was a former member of the Westbrook Kiwanis Club.

Westbrook, Jan. 17.—Ex-Mayor Otis S. Trafton, 71, long identified in the shoe business in Maine and New Hampshire and for several years active in local politics, died suddenly this afternoon in his home, 458 Main Street. He and Mrs. Trafton had just returned from visiting their son, Norman E. Trafton, Falmouth, when Mr. Trafton was stricken with a heart attack on the piazza of his home and fell dead.

Mr. Trafton had served in the City Council, seven years as city clerk, and one term as mayor. He served in the State Legislature in 1911.

He was born at Harrison, April 12, 1875, son of the late James A. and Araminta Chaplin Trafton and moved here in his early youth, attending the local schools. He was graduated from Westbrook High School in 1904.

Mr. Trafton left Westbrook in 1915 and for a short time operated a shoe store at Bath, and then moved to Claremont, N. H., where he had a shoe business for 19 years. He returned here 12 years ago from Kennebunk, where he was proprietor of a shoe store several years. He had operated Trafton's Shoe Store here before he moved in 1915 and opened another store on his return in Vallee Square.

He was a member of the Westbrook Congregational Church, Warren Phillips Lodge, AF&AM; Eagle Royal Arch Chapter, RS&M; Westbrook Council; St. Alban Commandery, Kora Temple Shrine, and Westbrook Kiwanis Club.

He and Mrs. Trafton, the former Ella Meserve, observed their 50th wedding anniversary last August.

Also surviving are a brother, Charles A. Trafton, Sanford; and three grandchildren, Mary Maxine, James Otis and Norman E. Trafton, jr., all of Falmouth.

Funeral services will be held at 2.30 p. m. Monday at 795 Main Street. Interment will be in Woodlawn Cemetery.

Mayor Ernest O. Porell announced tonight that the city offices will be closed from 2.30 to 3.30 p. m. Monday in respect to the former mayor. James F. Sullivan, president of the Westbrook Chamber of Commerce, announced that the stores will be closed at the same hour.

He was a member of King Solomons Lodge, Waldoboro, the Waldoboro Lions Club, and the United Methodist Church.

He is survived by his wife of 65 years, of Waldoboro; and three sons, Edwin A., of Ephrata, Pa.; Charles III, of Wilmington, Del.; and Jon W., of Port Jefferson Station, N.Y.

A brother, Edward, who died in 1989.
