NEW GLOUCESTER — One of this town's oldest residents, Albert D. True, 90, died yesterday in an Auburn nursing home after a brief illness.

He was born Dec. 6, 1874, in New Gloucester, son of John W. and Caroline Murdock True. He attended New Gloucester schools and graduated with the Bates College class of 1898.

For many years he taught high school in Francistown, N. H., and later in Blue Hill and Oxford, Maine.

Charles Augustus True

Funeral services for Charles Augustus True, 74, a native of Portland and county attorney here two terms, will be held Sunday in New York City, where he died Thursday. Prayers and interment will be at the True lot in Evergreen Cemetery at 12.15 p. m. Monday. Mr. True had been ill since January and was suddenly stricken with spinal paralysis while recuperating in Florida.

He was born here Nov. 30, 1860, of Colonial ancestry, the son of Samuel A. True, old Maine merchant, and Ellen Hart True, daughter of Hanson M. Hart, wool manufacturer. His grandfather was Samuel True, one of the founders of the Woodman, True Company.

After graduating from Portland High School in 1878, a Brown Medal scholar, he entered Colby College, graduating in 1882. He was a member of the Delta Kappa Epsilon and Phi Beta Kappa Fraternities at Colby. He studied law with the late Judge Clarence Hale, with Symonds & Libby, and at the Harvard Law School and was admitted to the Cumberland County Bar in 1885.

He married Gertrude Akers Paine, daughter of Henry L. Paine in this city in 1888 and the same year was elected councilman from Ward Four. A year later Mr. True was appointed assistant county attorney and afterwards served two terms as county attorney. While practising his profession here he established a reputation as jury lawyer, a reputation he continued to enjoy since moving to New York City 20 years ago.

Mr. True was a member of the Baptist Church, of Ancient Landmark Lodge, F. & A. M., Longfellow Lodge, K. of P., and of Harmony Lodge, I. O. O. F., all of this city.

Two children, Gertrude and Samuel Nelson True, were born in this city and Mrs. True died. Several years later he married Mrs. Laura Hatton Smith of New York City, who sur-

vives him, as does his daughter, now residing in San Diego, and a sister, Mrs. Edward C. Robinson, of Brookline, Mass.

YARMOUTH — Paul A. True, who spent the past 20 years ensuring that Yarmouth's war dead were honored with flags each Memorial Day, died Friday.

A lifelong resident of Yarmouth, Mr. True was 67 when he died at his residence on West Main Street. He had fought cancer for the past six years.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

For most of his life, Mr. True respected and reveled in war history and the men and women who fought for their country.

His father had served in World War I and Mr. True himself joined the Air Force in 1952. He was a member of the Air Force 104 AC&W "Pete's Boys," stationed at Fort Preble and later was reassigned to the 102nd Division and served in

Libya during the Korean conflict.

When he returned to Yarmouth, he became a member of the Anderson Mayberry Post #91 and eventually became treasurer.

As his five children were growing up, he taught them the importance of Memorial Day. Each year, he would take them along as he planted flags at the graves of veterans buried in the town's cemeteries.

Mr. True would hand his children cemetery maps and a handful of flags as they walked through the town's graveyards.

"There was no laughing and carrying on while we were doing the job," said Mr. True's son, Philip, of Yarmouth. "And he always told us 'Never, ever drop the flag on the ground. Always

show it respect."

Mr. True enjoyed collecting military vehicles and bought himself a 1944 troop carrier that he drove in Memorial Day parades.

"It was huge and he kept it by the side of the house," said Mr. True's daughter, Julie Wilson, who lives in North Yarmouth. "Everybody knew it was there."

One of Mr. True's lifelong desires was to fly in a World War II aircraft, and he got his wish in 1992 after retiring from his postal carrier job at the Yarmouth post office. His family and postal workers chipped in to buy him a seat on the "909 Flying Fortress," a bomber used in the war. Though the flight was a short one from Portland to Rockland, Mr. True was overwhelmed to sit aboard the famed airplane.

"He loved it," said son Philip True. "He said it was phenomenal."

Mr. True was born in Westbrook, a son of Paul A. and Ruth Davis True. He attended Yarmouth schools and graduated from North Yarmouth Academy in 1947. During high school, he served in the Maine State Guard.

After returning from the Air Force, Mr. True worked at True's Greenhouses with his father, where he enjoyed raising roses and obtained his nickname, "Rosebud."

He later ran True's Shell Station, and worked for the town of Yarmouth's road commissioner and Barbour's store. In 1992, he retired after 26 years with the U.S. Postal Service.

He served on the Yarmouth Volunteer Fire Department. For many years, he was a secretary for Anderson

Mayberry Post. He was a member of the Casco Lodge, Merrimack Valley Military Vehicle Collectors, 470 Club in New Hampshire, Antiques Power Club, Maine State Police Auxiliary, National Association of Theater Organs, and Brothers of the Bush. He was a lifetime member of the Winnegance Chapter.

Surviving are two daughters, Julie T. Wilson of North Yarmouth and Elizabeth A. True of Denver, Colo.; three sons, Gerald P. of New Gloucester, Philip A. of Yarmouth and George A. of North Yarmouth; and two grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at First Parish Congregational Church, with the Rev. Peter Plagge officiating. Spring burial will be in Riverside Cemetery. Arrangements are by the Lindquist Funeral Home.

From 1960 until his retirement he owned and operated Trumbull's Hardware with his son, C. Allan Trumbull. He was also co-owner with his wife of the Joe Jones Sports Shop in North Conway, N.H.

His political career spanned four decades. He served in the 99th Maine Legislature and was vice chairman of the Maine Executive Council for two years.

He was chairman of the Maine State Liquor Commission from 1972 to 1979.

He was a selectman here for 17 years.

Mr. Trumbull was active in civic and fraternal affairs and served as president of the Fryeburg Chamber of Commerce and the Fryeburg-Lovell Kiwanis Club. He was master of the Pythagorean Masonic Lodge and was high priest of Oriental Chapter, Bridgton.

He was a member of Fryeburg Congregational Church and Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston. He was active in the Fryeburg Fair Association for 20 years, serving as its publicity director and later as treasurer.

He married Mary Sanborn in 1933. She died in 1960.

In 1966, he married Ruth Northrop Jones.
