H. Newhall Tukey of 46 Noyes St., a retired freight claims agent for the Maine Central Railroad, died yesterday in a local hospital following a brief illness.

He died on his 66th birthday.

A World War I Navy veteran, Mr. Tukey first joined MCRR in 1920 as a clerk in the office of the auditor of passenger accounts. He was promoted eight years later and transferred to the freight claim bureau of the railroad, where he became assistant to the freight agent in 1946 and freight agent three years later. He retired last year after 42 years of railroad service.

Mr. Tukey was born May 21, 1897, in Andover, son of Henry H. and Eva A. Newhall Tukey.

He was a member of the Williston Congregational Church and the Cumberland Club.

Funeral services will be at 2 p. m. Monday at Williston Congregational Church for Dr. Philip E. Tukey, 61, prominent Portland dentist and former city councilor, who died Saturday in a local hospital of a heart ailment. Interment will be in Pine Grove Cemetery, Falmouth.

He had been in failing health for several months, but was up and around until Friday afternoon. He retired from active practice in March.

He was born in Westbrook, July 24, 1889, son of the late Dr. Henry H. Tukey and Harriet Ayers Tukey, and moved to Portland at an early age. He was graduated from Portland High

School and Harvard Dental School in 1913 with a DMD degree, and started his dentistry practice here the same year.

Doctor Tukey was a member of the staff of the Maine Eye and Ear Infirmary, former member of the medical board of the Pownal State School for the Feeble Minded, and during World War II was a member of the local Selective Service Board. He served on the former Portland Common Council in 1917.

A 32nd degree Mason, he was affiliated with several Masonic organizations including Ancient Landmark Lodge, Greenleaf Chapter, Scottish Rites, Portland Commandery, Knights Templar, Knights of Constantine, Kora Temple Shrine and the Royal Order of Jesters.

He also was a member of the Williston Congregational Church, the Filibrown Dental Club of Portland, the Greater Portland Dental Club, a charter member of the Portland Kiwanis Club, and a former member of the Cumberland Club and Portland Club.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Margery Blake Tukey, 801 Shore Road, Cape Elizabeth; three sons, Col. Philip E. Tukey, jr., Bangor, commanding officer of the 101st Fighter Group of the Air National Guard of Maine, and Howard G. and Spaulding M. Tukey, South Portland; five grandchildren; a brother, Newhall Tukey, and a sister, Miss Marion Tukey, Portland.

RICHARD C. TUKEY

Richard C. Tukey, 84, of Waldoboro, died Sat., June 5. He was born in Newcastle, April 23, 1915 the son of Robert K. and Flora Burns Tukey.

Richard was a graduate of Lincoln Academy, he attended New York University and the University of Mississippi. He had been in the newspaper business for over twenty-five years. During his career he has interviewed such prominent international figures as Henry Cabot Lodge, General Willard Wyman of NATO, and General Maderias who was head of the continental U.S. Army. Richard spent much of his life in newspaper work, employment by The Lincoln County News, the Waldoboro Press and as editor of the Eastern Arizona Courier, Safford, Ariz.

Richard retired in 1977, from Homes Unlimited in Bangor, where he was administrator. Mr. Tukey was an Army Veteran of WWII, serving in the European theater. He received the Purple Heart and other decorations, being discharged after five years service as a 1st Sgt.

He was a member of the Riverside Masonic Lodge #135, and Lakeview Chapter #179, Order of the Eastern Star, both in Jefferson. He was a Past Post Commander of the Damariscotta V.F.W. and a member of the Damariscotta American Legion. He was Commodore of the Twin Village Yacht and was Lincoln County Trap and Shooting Champion in the 1930's.

He is survived by his wife, Helen Sprague Tukey, of Waldoboro; one daughter, Robyn Tukey, of Damariscotta; two brothers, Edward Tukey of Togus and Hale Tukey of Damariscotta; two grandchildren, Tamara Kingston of Brookline, Mass. and Sean Kingston of Wiscasset; four step-grandchildren, Anna McArthur of Farmingdale, Theresa Gaghan of Lewiston, Lisa Cook of Winthrop and Mary Hutchinson of Bethel; seven great-grandchildren; several nieces, nephew, and cousins.
