Funeral services for the Rev. M. Joseph Twomey, DD, 77, of 41 Rackleff Street, retired Baptist minister who died Friday in a local hospital will be held at 2 p. m. Monday at the First Baptist Church.

Prayers will be held at 2 p. m. Wednesday at the Chapel in Evergreen Cemetery, Centerville, Conn.

A former pastor of the First Baptist Church, here, he had filled pastorates in Philadelphia, Pa., and Newark and North Orange, N. J.

Dr. Twomey was born at Killarney, Ireland, Jan. 10, 1871, and came to the United States at the age of 19. He spent his earlier years at Norwich, Conn., and attended Suffield Literary Institute, Suffield, Conn. He entered Brown University in the Fall of 1896, working his way by employment in a local market and incidentally serving as supply preacher at a nearby church. He was graduated from Brown in 1900, and from Newton Theological Institution in 1903.

Ordained that year, he served as pastor of the Baptist Church, Danielson, Conn., two years before coming here. The Portland pastorate of nine years was marked by his aggressive leadership in the spiritual and material work of the church.

He was a member of the general committee in charge of arrangements for the city-wide Chapman - Alexander evangelistic campaign in January, 1910.

Th/ Portland pastorate was followed by one of 16 years with the Peddie Memorial Baptist Church, Newark, N. J. From there he was called to the Baptist Temple Church in Philadelphia, Pa., which was founded by the late Dr. Russell H. Conwell, noted lecturer and minister, and he served there from 1930 to 1935.

Dr. Twomey was pastor of the North Orange, N. J., Baptist Church from 1937 to 1942, after

an interim period in which he served in evangelistic and pastoral relations outside the specific pastorate. Upon completing his ministry at North Orange he retired from active pastoral work, in order to serve churches needing evangelistic leadership.

During World War II he served as interim-pastor of his former church in this city from October, 1942, to February, 1943, and with the First Baptist Church, Williamsport, Pa., from 1943 to 1946, during the period its pastor was serving as a chaplain with the armed services.

From 1913 to 1919 he was a member of the Executive Committee of the Northern Baptist Convention and from 1922 to 1937 he served on the Executive Board of the American Baptist Foreign Mission Society. While pastor here he was a member of the board of the Maine Baptist Convention, 1908-1914, and was president of the Maine Sunday School Association, now the Maine Council of Churches, in 1913-14.

While pastor in Philadelphia he was president of the Baptist Convention of Pennsylvania, 1931-35. He had served on the board of the New Jersey Baptist Convention from 1916 to 1930. Moore Tyler, he moved here at a young age, attended local schools and graduated from South Portland High School, where he was a football and track star.

During World War II, Mr. Tyler worked at Air Reduction, a plant in the South Portland shipyards that manufactured oxygen for the war effort. In the '40s and '50s, he lobstered off Cape Elizabeth and represented Southern Maine for American Hardware Mutual

Insurance Co.

His daughter Donna recalls as special the times she was allowed to go with him on day-long sales trips through the Maine countryside. "People loved my father," she said. "In every town we drove into, someone would wave and shout hello to Daddy. I thought he was famous."

Mr. Tyler loved to tell stories of his boyhood, the sea and life in the Maine woods. For more than 60 years, he fished, hunted and walked around his beloved Wilsons Mills and Arisechos Mountain. When close friend Richard Berman drove Tug to Wilsons Mills last fall, he remarked of their trip, "Tug had a story for every bend in the road." An avid collector of rocks and minerals for 50 years, Mr. Tyler also enjoyed weekends rock-hunting and panning for gold.

In 1957 Mr. Tyler moved to Bar Harbor to manage C.E. Marcy's Insurance Co. there. He achieved the Master Mason degree at Bar Harbor Lodge 185.

On returning to the Portland area two years later, he co-founded Algonquin Realty and later was co-owner of Scarborough Realty. He joined Harnden Realty of South Portland in 1971 and owned Tyler Agency, his own insurance business.

He remained with Harnden through 1992, when poor health dictated a reluctant retirement at the age of 77.

Mr. Tyler served on the South Portland Board of Zoning Appeals from 1967 to 1977 and was a member of the Assessment Review Board for District 3 from 1979 to 1982. For 30 years Mr. Tyler was involved with Bayview Cemetery here as president or trustee.

Surviving are his wife of 57 years, Thelma L. Tyler of South Portland; a daughter, Donna Tyler Cummings of Portland; two granddaughters, Caitlin Cummings of Portland and Erin Cummings of New York City; a sister, Frances Taylor of South Portland; and many nieces and nephews, including an especially close nephew, John Taylor II of Scarborough.
