

He was a member of the Chestnut Street United Methodist Church and a member of the Methodist Men. His wife, the former Anna Rosa



William L. VanBlarcom, 56, a lifelong resident of Greater Fortland, for the past 16 years employed in the merchant marine, died suddenly Thursday night in his home at 603 Preble Street, South Portland. He returned last week from a voyage to Antwerp, Belgium.

Born in Portland Nov. 13, 1890, the son of the late Herman L. and Ella Dimmock VanBlarcom, he received his education in the Portland schools. He was for many years engaged in the grocery business in the city before entering the U. S. Marine Service, in which he was a cook for a

long period.

He was a member of Ancient Land Mark Lodge, AF&AM, Portland.



Funeral services will be at 2.30 p. m., Friday at 24 Bean Street, South Portland and interment in Forest City Cemetery.





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
