pharmacist, beekeeper, gardener

YARMOUTH — Roger N. Vaughan, 82, a longtime pharmacist and beekeeper, died of a heart attack Tuesday while snowblowing his driveway.

Mr. Vaughan was a pharmacist for 56 years. His first store was Vaughan's Pharmacy at 139 Main St. It was in a historic building that had been the site of a pharmacy

for over 150 years. He ran it for 17 years, from right after World War II until the early 1960s.

Mr. Vaughan and his family lived above the pharmacy before moving in 1960 to the Captain Prince House on Gilman Road at Princes Point. After he sold Vaughan's Pharmacy he opened another, Gray Pharmacy on Route 100 in Gray.

Both stores included a lunch counter and soda fountain that were popular with the regular customers and local students.

"He took great pride in the soda fountain," said his daughter, Vesta Rand. "He was a quiet, modest man who was very gentle in his approach to people. That is the way he treated his pharmacy."

Mr. Vaughan retired in the early 1980s and sold Gray Pharmacy to Brooks Drugs. He then devoted his time to his hobbies of beekeeping and gardening.

Mr. Vaughn was born in North Hyde Park, Vt., a son of Elnathan and Florence Manning Vaughan. He grew up in Cumberland and attended Greely Institute (now Greely High School) and Gorham Normal School.

He was active in Yarmouth town affairs and served on the school board in the 1950s and 1960s during construction of Yarmouth High School. He was a member of First Parish Congregational Church and the Yarmouth and Casco Lodge of Masons.

Mr. Vaughan and his wife, Virginia Wright Vaughan, traveled extensively during their retirement. Mrs. Vaughan died in 1992.

Surviving are a son, Roger Jr. of Old Orchard Beach; two daughters, Vesta Rand of Gray and Marjorie Manning Vaughan of Yarmouth; a sister, Alice Read of Raymond; a brother, Robert, of Palm Harbor, Fla.; and three grandsons.

He graduated from Castine High School, the University of Maine, Class of '38, and Harvard Law School, Class of '41. He enlisted in the Army in 1941 and served with the 88th Infantry in North Africa and Italy. He was a member of the "Blue Devils" of the 88th Infantry Division, he was honorably discharged with the rank of captain in 1946, at which time he joined the law firm of Eaton & Peabody. On Jan. 1, 1949, he was made a partner in the firm known as Eaton, Peabody, Bradford & Veague, now Eaton Peabody. He retired from the practice of law in 1986. He was active in the Bangor community. SUKKI — Herbert Henry Vickers, 87, died Jan. 12, 1994, at his residence. He was born July 12, 1906, in Walney Island, Barrow-in-Furness, England, the son of Frederick James and Lillian (Hargreaves) Vickers. He graduated from Southampton College, England and had some training in many trades through jobs in shipyards. He emigrated to the United States, settling in New Jersey. He married Laura Clegg, who had been his childhood friend since they met in primary school. He was employed as a civil engineer in New Jersey on bridge and road construction projects and as a mechanical engineer. He started with Esso as a mechanical engineer in the research and development department in Linden, N.J., where he was instrumental in process design and product development, particularly in synthetic rubbers and plastics. Over 35 patents are registered in his name through Standard Oil in New Jersey. Of all of Standard Oil's thousands of scientists and engineers, Harry was the twelfth person in it's history to be chosen to be given the additional title of Research Scientist. He was an ardent participant in skiing, starting in the early days before the development of lifts. Having broken his knee at the Ranch Camp at Stowe Mountain, Vt. in the 30's, Harry responded to his own pain and helped to develop the National Ski Patrol in the East. He established the Esso Ski Patrol in the 50's and the Bald Mountain Ski Patrol in Dedham, Me. He wore Ski Patrol No. 1162. He helped to develop the first methods of the chair life evacuation patrol, first repelling themselves off stalled chairlifts and then extracting the skiers. He was also an ardent tennis player as a member of the Blue Hill Country Club, the Holiday Inn of Ellsworth and the Racquet and Fitness Club in Trenton. He had an equal passion for yachting and participated for many years in the Retired Skippers Race in Castine, gaining one first and two third places with his own yacht, the "Salty Lass." He was a member of the Coast Guard Auxiliary in Bucksport and one of the founders of the Abanaki Yacht Club. He was the first clam

warden and plumbing inspector for the Town of Surry. He was also a licensed first aid and swimming instructor for the American Red Cross. He was a member of Lygonia Lodge No. 40 AF & AM of Ellsworth. He is survived by a daughter, Sheila and her husband, Donald Hopkins of Reeders, Pa.; a son, H. James and his wife, Barbara Vickers of Hampden; one brother, James Vickers of Boulder, Colo.; one sister, Florence Webb of Palo Alto, Calif.; seven grandchildren, many great-grandchildren and step-grandchildren. Harry and his wife, Laura, were fortunate enough to be able to enjoy their retirement and health together for over 20 years and were able to travel much of the world seeing Alaska, Hawaii, South Africa, Egypt and of course their native and beloved England many times.

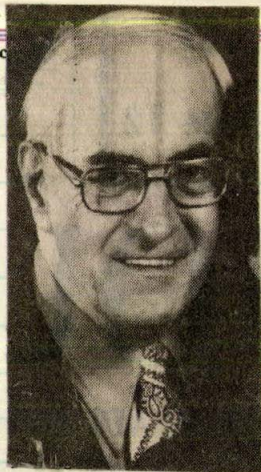

Frank M. Vickery Jr., 65, of 11 Marston St., Auburn, died unexpectedly Monday evening aboard the cruise ship Nordic Prince while sailing in the Caribbean.
