Lieut. James H. Vickery, 70, of 265 Spring Street, retired member of the Portland Fire Department, died Wednesday night in the State Street Hospital after an illness of two years. He had been critically ill the past four months.

Born in Portland, April 18, 1870, Vickery attended the local schools and was for many years engaged in the florist business on Spring Street before receiving a permanent appointment to the Fire Department. He was a call fireman from November, 1890, until made a permanent member April 14, 1919. He was a member of Engine Three on Brackett Street as a call man and as a permanent fireman was first with Engine Two, Munjoy Hill, and then Combination 11, Ocean Avenue, where he was serving when retired in 1930. His promotion from private to lieutenant came Feb. 4, 1922.

He was a 32nd degree Mason, including Ancient Landmark Lodge, which he joined June 1, 1892, and St. Alban Commandery. He was also a member of Bramhall Lodge, K. of P., and Samoset Tribe of Red Men, and of St. Luke's Cathedral parish.

He was unmarried and is survived by three sisters, Miss Mary M. Vickery and Mrs. Mabel G. Melaugh, both of Portland, and Mrs. Alice Prieser of Brooklyn, N. Y., and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be at 2.30 p. m. Saturday in Wilde Memorial Chapel and interment in Evergreen Cemetery.

UNITY — William T. Vickery, 83, of Depot Street died Saturday evening at a Waterville hospital following a long illness. He was born in Clark, Wyo., June 27, 1901, son of Eli and Carrie Brandenburg Vickery.

He came to Maine in 1933. For several years, he farmed and sold general and life insurance. During World War II, he recruited farm laborers for the University of Maine Extension Service. At one time, he supervised two trainloads of men from Kentucky who came to Maine to dig potatoes.

Following World War II, he bought pulpwood for the Dead River Co. and later went into business for himself, continuing to sell insurance until 1978. In 1980, he sold his pulpwood business and retired.

Mr. Vickery helped bring several businesses to Unity including Redi-Peel Potatoes and Milmac Fence Co. He developed Vickery Lane as a residential area and the town honored him by naming the street after him. He was one of the 10

original founders of Unity College.

He was a charter member of Unity Fire Department and served as treasurer for 25 years.

Mr. Vickery was active in scouting serving as Unity scoutmaster for a time and for many years was an active member of the Katahdin Area Council. His dedication and service won him the Silver Beaver Award, the highest award given an adult scouter.

For a number of years, he served as moderator for Unity town meetings.

He was a member of Star in the West Lodge Masons, Unity and attended the Unity Union Church.

Survivors include his wife, Margaret Sandilands Vickery of Unity; two sons, Michael of Adelaide, Australia, and Erwin of Burnsville, Minn.; one daughter, Kathleen of Billings, Mont.; one brother, Frederick, and one sister, Carol Myers, both of Anaconda, Mont.; four grandchildren; several neices, nephews and cousins.

AUGUSTA, Sept. 9 (Special)—Blaine S. Viles, 64, for many years one of the most extensive lumber operators in Maine, long prominent in Republican political circles of the State and holder of many public offices, died this morning in his home at 154 State Street.

Born at North New PO July 22, 1879, he was educated in the public schools there, was a member of the class of 1898

at Skowhegan High School, Bowdoin College, 1903, and Yale Forest School, 1904.

Although his chief business remained in lumbering, or associated industries, his other activities in business included directorship in the Augusta Trust Company, the National Bank of Commerce in Portland, the Kennebec Log Driving Company; director and treasurer of the Kennebec Land Company; president and

treasurer of the Pine Tree Timberland Company; vice president and director of the Kennebec Valley Protective Association; president and treasurer of the C. M. Rice Paper Company of Portland and a partner in Viles and Gannett Timberlands.

Aided In Maine Films

He was one of the first men in Maine to see the possibilities in this State for the production of motion pictures and made possible in 1919 the Edgar Jones Production Company, later the Holman Day Productions, Inc., which featured plays made from the stories of the Maine author.

Mason, member of Delta Kappa Upsilon Fraternity, Augusta Lodge of Elks, the Society of American Foresters and a past president of the Augusta Rotary Club.

Surviving are his widow, the former Ethel Johnson of Hallowell; a daughter, Mrs. Sanford L. Fogg, Jr., of Augusta, and a son, Capt. William Payson Viles, an Air Corps instructor at Minneapolis, Minn., besides several grandchildren.

He was a member of the Republican State committee, for many years chairman of the Kennebec county Republican committee and chairman of the Augusta Republican committee. Mr. Viles was a 32nd degree

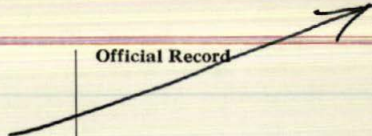

BOOTHBAY HARBOR — Parker H. Vincent, 83, of Commercial Street and Clearwater, Fla., died Monday at Maine Medical Center in Portland after a brief illness.

He was born in Malden, Mass., a son of Frederick H. and Miriam P. Clark Vincent, and spent his youth on Cape Cod, where he married Madelyn L. Bassett on Sept. 23, 1937.

After serving as chief engineer and manager of several radio stations, he worked for a consulting engineering firm in Manchester, N.H., where he was responsible for the development of a remote control system for broadcasting stations. He traveled nationally selling, installing and servicing the systems.

He made a study for broadcasters headed by former Gov. Horace Hildreth that led to installation of a transmission tower on Mt. Washington. Mr. Vincent was later hired to build and run a station there, WMTW-TV, in the fall of 1954.

The third owner of WMTW-TV, Harrison Communications Corp., made him director of engineering at the Philadelphia-based company. His office remained in Maine, and he commuted to Boothbay Harbor on weekends until his retirement in 1983, after 30 years of service. He was the first engineer honored by the Maine

Association of Broadcasters for his service in the industry.

He lived in Auburn and Poland Spring and then Boothbay Harbor. In 1964, he bought a 35-foot motor yacht and berthed it at the former Boatel Boothbay.

Mr. Vincent was a member of Trinity Episcopal Church in Lewiston where he was a senior warden, diocesan delegate, member of the diocesan standing committee, and as a lay reader licensed by the former Bishop Oliver Loring.

He was a life member of Tyrian Lodge in Mechanic Falls, Casco Bay Power Squadron, a chorister with Lincoln Arts Festival Chorus, and a life member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers.

A son, Lee, died previously.

Surviving are his wife of 62 years of Boothbay Harbor; three daughters, Madelyn M. Huffmire of Ocean Point and Mansfield Center, Conn., Anne F. Durand of Arlington, Va., and Valerie S. Vincent of Boothbay Harbor; seven grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

Visiting hours will be 6 to 8 p.m. Thursday at Simmons, Harrington and Hall Funeral Home with a Masonic service at 7 p.m. A funeral will be held at 11 a.m. Friday at the funeral home with a burial at 2 p.m. in Mt. Auburn Cemetery in Auburn.
