TOPSHAM - Edward H. Vose, 81, of 43 Marc Ave., who ran several area businesses, died Sunday at a Brunswick hospital.

He was born at Knox, a son of Fred and Almatio Nelson Vose, and attended Liberty schools.

On Oct. 28, 1934, he married Althea J. Merrill.

During World War II, he was an assistant director of transportation at Bath Iron Works.

In 1952, he came to Brunswick.

Mr. Vose was a pilot in the Portland chapter of the Civil Air Patrol. He was also a longtime businessman in the Brunswick area, and owned the Vose Esso service center, a Ford garage in Lisbon Falls and operated a grocery store.

He was a 50-year member of the United Lodge of Masons and a member of the Kora Temple Shrine, Lewiston. He was also a past member of the Brunswick Rotary Club and a former Deacon at St. Paul's Episcopal Church.

Surviving are his wife of Topsham; two sons, Paul of Derry, N.H., and Fred of Brunswick; two daughters, Joan Staples of Houston, Texas, and Paula Robbins of Brunswick; two brothers, Gerald of Machias and Richard of Calais; two sisters, Annie Williams of Waite and Belle McKusick of Dexter; 12 grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

THOMASTON, Dec. 27. (Special)—
Edwin S. Vose of Cushing, well known as shipjoiner and surveyor, and a former member of the Maine Legislature, died Wednesday at the home of Charles A. Vose in this place.

Mr. Vose was born in Cushing Jan. 10, 1858, and first ran for public office in 1892, when he was Republican candidate for the Legislature from that town. He served as selectman of Cushing nine years, assessor seven, superintendent of schools five years, and also was deputy sheriff. He was candidate for Judge of Probate of Knox county in three campaigns. He was a member of the Grange and the Masons, and a past master of Orient Lodge, F. & A. M., of this town. For 10 years he served as a warden following the establishment of the Sea and Shore Fisheries Commission.
