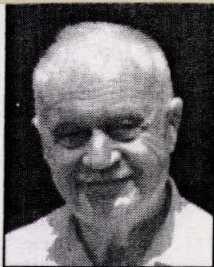

## George Wakely Jr.

SKOWHEGAN — George Nelson Wakely Jr., 83, died Friday, April 9, 1999, in Skowhegan.

He was born March 13, 1916, in Clinton, son of the late Lottie Dodge Wakely and George N. Wakely Sr., and graduated from Clinton High School in 1933.

At an early age, he was a student of the piano and later gave piano lessons for 35 students. He was christened at the age of six months in the Methodist Church in Clinton and in later years played the piano and organ in that church for 12 years.

He had three violinists, Erwin Stanley, Colby Robinson and Everett Rummels, who accompanied him, all deceased now.

He joined five lodges and played the Degree Work for all of them. He was a Mason until his death.

All during high school, he worked nights, after school and all day Saturdays in Clinton grocery stores. In 1934 he started work as a window trimmer and later as manager of the housewares department for the W.B. Arnold Co. on Waterville's Main Street. He worked a year in Brunswick and several months in the South Portland shipyards prior to being drafted for World War II in the Eighth Air Force. He traveled to Europe on the Queen Mary and returned years later on the Queen Elizabeth. He graduated from the Radio Mechanic Army School in Madison, Wis., and spent the next year in training in Orlando, Fla.

Soon after arriving in England with the 355th Fighter Group, he was transferred to be a chaplain's assistant for the remainder of his service. After the war ended, he spent six months in Germany with the Army of Occupation and then returned to Birmingham, England, for three months awaiting his trip home and discharge from Camp Devens. When he first arrived there, he was kept there for three months to play piano for a musical review that the camp was putting on. He returned to his former position at W.B. Arnold Co. after discharge and later became department manager and player for the Waterville Hardware Co. on lower Main Street in Waterville. He retired from there after 25 years in 1978. His work there required two 10-day trips yearly to New York City and Boston buying gifts for the then-largest gift department in Waterville. After his retirement, he worked part-time for the Blake Hardware Store for eight years.

He lost his first wife to cancer in 1961 after 14 years, and 11 of those years Mildred MacIntyre Viles Wakely taught school in Waterville

Junior High School. He lost his second wife, Marguerite Walke Wakely, to cancer in 1998. She assisted her husband in his gift-buying trips. After 30 years of living in Waterville, he and his wife moved to Skowhegan in 1990, and he lost his wife after nine years of ovarian cancer.

Survivors include his stepson Robert Viles, of Concord, N.H., where he is the dean of the Franklin Pierce Law School; his niece Ernestine Sawyer, of Titusville, Fla., and her two children, Debra Sulanski, of Toana, Va., and Jon Boutillier, of Titusville, Fla.; his nephew, Vernon Garrett, of Kennebunk; and several cousins.

At his request there will be no funeral service or calling hours.

A graveside service will be held at the Walker-Wakely lot in the Hartland Cemetery at a later date. In lieu of flowers, memorial donations to local animal shelters are encouraged. Arrangements are by Direct Cremation of Maine in Belfast.
