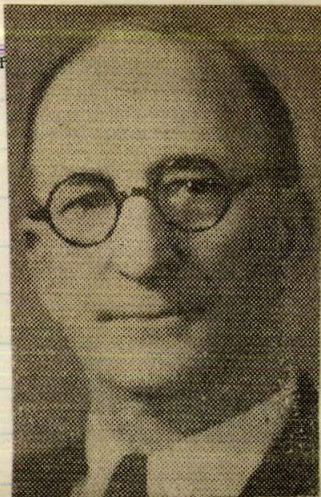

The funeral of Frank S. Waldron, president of J. E. Goold and Company, who died Friday at his home, 112 Vaughan Street, will be held from the residence at 2.30 p. m. Tuesday.

Mr. Waldron was born in Hartland, son of the late Eben and Georgianna Waldron. His parents removed soon after his birth to Pittsfield, where Mr. Waldron received his education. Interested in the drug business early in life, he studied pharmacy at Maine Central Institute, from which he was graduated. He became a registered druggist in 1897.

At the outbreak of the Spanish-American War in 1898, Mr. Waldron enlisted as a pharmacist and served two years in Cuba where he was in charge of all hospital supplies. He returned to Maine at the war's close and entered the employ of Stone's Drug Store at Norway.

In 1904 Mr. Waldron married Miss Alice L. Pride of Portland, who survives him. He became president of J. E. Goold and Company in 1905.

With his characteristic determination and ambition, Mr. Waldron devoted his entire time to the business which became under his leadership one of the leading wholesale drug houses in New England. He was loved and respected by all his employes for his unfailing loyalty to them and was held in high esteem by the drug trade throughout this section for his keen business judgment and his thorough knowledge of the business itself.

Until poor health forced him to retire, six years ago, Mr. Waldron was an active member of the National Wholesale Druggists' Association, the New England Drug Exchange, the Maine Pharmaceutical Association, the Portland Club and the Portland Country Club.

Mr. Waldron was a 32nd degree Mason, holding memberships in Norway, in Portland Commandery No. 2,

the Shrine Club of Portland and Kora Temple, Lewiston. Surviving, in addition to Mrs. Waldron, are one son, Joseph G. Waldron and two grandchildren, Betty and William Waldron, all of Portland.

in third generation to run law firm

SACO — Edwin G. Walker, 83, a Biddeford lawyer who help guide the former St. Francis College through some difficult years, died Tuesday at the Maine Veterans' Home in Scarborough. He lived at 401 Main St. for many years.

Mr. Walker had a busy law practice in the Masonic Building on Main Street in Biddeford. The firm was established by his grandfather, N.B. Walker, and he was the third generation to run the firm.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

Through the years he donated a lot of legal work, especially for Sweetser Children's Home, University of New England, Southern Maine Medical Center and the Wardwell Home for the Aged.

"He helped a lot of people," said Connie Laflamme, his friend and longtime secretary. "He

was a poor man's attorney. For people who couldn't pay, he would sometimes go to their home for a meal, and accept that as his pay."

"He never thought about being paid," said his daughter, Eunice "Tink" Nussbaum. "The most important part was whether he could help the person. I'd go down Main Street and a grocer would offer me an orange, or they would let me and my friends into the movies for free. It was always because dad had done things for people."

Mr. Walker retired due to ill health in the mid-1980s, and the office is now a branch of the Jensen, Baird, Gardner & Henry law firm.

He was a trustee of the former St. Francis College for many years, and saw the college through some difficult years in the 1960s and 1970s. He was presented an honorary doctorate from the University of New England in 1984 for his contribution in helping the former St. Francis transform from a small private college into a growing health sciences-oriented university.

Born in Biddeford, a son of Thomas Butler and Alice Chick Walker, he graduated in 1930 from Biddeford High School, in 1931 from Hebron Academy and in 1936 from Bowdoin College. During World War II he was a Navy lieutenant commander, serving as a navigator aboard a destroyer and a submarine rescue ship. After the war he received a law degree from Harvard Law School.

Mr. Walker enjoyed travel, and he was fluent in several languages. He enjoyed reading, reciting and writing poetry, some of it humorous. He went skiing in the Alps most recently at age 74, and he was also a gourmet cook.

"He was so fun to listen to," said Laflamme. "He could converse at every level."

He was a former Biddeford District Court judge, a recorder for the Maine Court and served on the Biddeford Board of Education. He was a trustee of Biddeford Savings Bank, McArthur Library, Biddeford-Saco Water Co., Southern Maine Medical Center and Greenwood Cemetery, Biddeford. He was a member of the Masons, a trustee of Trinity Episcopal Church, Saco.

His wife, Dorothy Peets Walker, died in 1983.

Surviving are two daughters, Eunice "Tink" Nussbaum of Cheimsford, Mass., and Georgioussa S. Kingston of Biddeford, Mass.; a brother, Roger Walker of South Portland; a sister, Pauline Deans of Lyman; and four grandchildren.

A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 2 p.m. Saturday at Trinity Episcopal Church. The Rev. Robert Mountford will officiate. Burial will be in Laurel Hill Cemetery.

Long active in Brownfield affairs, he served as a chairman of the board

of selectmen and three terms on the school board. During the 1960s he represented Brownfield and five neighboring towns in the state House of Representatives.

Mr. Walker was longtime trustee of Fryeburg Academy and the oldest past master of Shepherd River Lodge of Masons, now Mount Moriah Lodge, of Brownfield. He was a charter member of Stone Chapter Order of the Eastern Star, a member of the Clarence Mulford Trust Committee, and a member of the Brownfield Community Church.

Born in Brownfield, son of Dean and Lutie Walker, he graduated in 1917 from Fryeburg Academy. He graduated in 1923 from Bowdoin College, and took graduate courses at Boston University and Harvard College.

He was a mathematics teacher at Dedham (Mass.) High School and a manager of W.T. Grant Co. stores in the Midwest before returning to Brownfield in 1937. He was principal of the former Bean Memorial High School for a few years in the late 1930s before joining his brothers in the Chevrolet dealership.

Surviving are his wife of 65 years, Christine Hofer Walker of Brownfield; two daughters, June Hammond of Fryeburg and Lois Moulton of Spring Green, Wis.; six grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
