Country Club.





riers in Maine, died last night in a Portland hospital where he had been a patient for several days.

Although Mr. Walker's activities had been limited in the last few years by poor health, he was seen frequently on the streets here until he suffered a heart attack recently.

He was a rural carrier out of the Harrison Post Office for 32 years until he retired in 1934. Recently he was honored on his 50th anniversary of membership in the National Rural Carriers Association.

Shortly after his retirement as a rural carrier he moved to Bridgton and operated a service station on Portland street. Fifteen years ago he acquired a service station on Main street and operated it until a short time ago.

Active in numerous musical organizations, Mr. Walker played the cymbals in the old Harrison band at the age of 10. Lated he switched to the bass horn and played in the Modern Woodmen band of Bridgton, Norway band, Bridgton band, and more recently the Kora Temple band in Lewiston.

was in business with his two late brothers, Edwin and Perley, at the Walker Chevrolet dealership in East Brownfield.

Mr. Walker was a semi-professional base-ball pitcher while at Bowdoin College, earning his tuition by playing summers throughout Maine and the Maritime-Provinces. He was inducted into the Maine Baseball Hall of Fame in 1981.

Long active in Brownfield affairs, he served as a chairman of the board

of selectmen and three terms on the school board. During the 1960s he represented Brownfield and five neighboring towns in the state House of Representatives.

Mr. Walker was longtime trustee of Fryeburg Academy and the oldest past master of Shepherd River Lodge of Masons, now Mount Moriah Lodge, of Brownfield. He was a charter member of Stone Chapter Order of the Eastern Star, a member of the Clarence Mulford Trust Committee, and a member of the Brownfield Community Church.

Born in Brownfield, son of Dean and Lutie Walker, Walker, he graduated in 1917 from Fryeburg Academy. He graduated in 1923 from Bowdoin College, and took graduate courses at Boston University and Harvard College.

He was a mathematics teacher at Dedham (Mass.). High School and a manager of W.T. Grant Co. stores in the Midwest before returning to Brownfield in 1937. He was principal of the former Bean Memorial High School for a few years in the late 1930s before joining his brothers in the Chevrolet dealership.

Surviving are his wife of 65 years, Christine Hofer Walker of Brownfield; two daughters, June Hammond of Fryeburg and Lois Moulton of Spring Green, Wis.; six grandchildren and two orwal orandchildren.
