"He said he was a gentleman and had to live up to his word," she said.

outdoorsman, assistant hatchery foreman

GRAY — Lawrence A. "Shiner" Walker, 83, a lifelong outdoorsman who worked 26 years for the Maine Department of Fish and Wildlife, died Thursday at his home here.

Mr. Walker worked many years at the state fish hatchery in Gray, retiring as assistant foreman. Before

that he was manager during the early 1950s of the state hatchery at Dead River Township.

He enjoyed hunting, fishing and trapping and engaged in those pastimes as often as he could, according to friends and family.

Mr. Walker was a regular contributor to the Sportsmen Say column in the Press Herald, written by Gene Letourneau. "He had quite a few firm thoughts on things," said his daughter, Linda Strout.

Mr. Walker argue in print on a few occasions in favor of controlling Maine's coyote population. "They (coyotes) are a smart animal, but they attack deer and newborn farm animals, and serve no useful purpose whatsoever," he said in a 1983 Press Herald story.

"He was quite a trapper," said Frank Robinson, a longtime friend. "He caught as many as 80 foxes in a season."

A trapper since age 14, Mr. Walker turned it into a job during his retirement. He gained notoriety in southern Maine as the man to see if you had a problem with skunks or other nuisance animals. "He would live-trap them and set them free someplace else," said Strout.

Mr. Walker was also vocal about his objection to the reduction of state fish hatcheries and feeding stations since 1929 from 49 down to nine.

"He was upset over the conditions in Sebago Lake," said Frank Robinson, a longtime friend. "He thinks there should be more fall fingerlings (small fish) stocked in the lake in the fall."

"If the biologists in Maine would listen to him, the fresh water fishing industry wouldn't be in the trouble it's in," said Peter Wescott, another friend. "He had a lot of knowledge as far as raising fish goes."

Mr. Walker had a workshop behind his house, where friends often gathered to talk about hunting and fishing. There he made hand-crafted wooden planters shaped like loons, sea gulls, deer and moose, which he sold to local gift and flower shops.

Born in South Portland, a son of Lawrence and Annie Messer Walker, he graduated from Lewiston High School. He was a logger for Diamond Match Co. for a while, and worked in the Saco-Lowell Shops during World War II.

He was a member of the Kingfield Masons.

Surviving are his wife of 60 years, Sylvia Allen Walker of Gray; two daughters, Linda Strout of Gorham and Sheryl Wilbur of Gray; a brother, Carroll of West Buxton; a sister, Arlene Woodward of West Buxton; five grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

Biddeford, March 20—Nathaniel B. Walker, 84, widely known southwest-ern Maine attorney, four times Mayor of this city, former member of the Legislature and a member of the engineering crew of the Boston and Maine Railroad when the line was built to Biddeford, died tonight at his home, 147 Alfred Street. He had been ill a long time.

Mr. Walker was a native of Biddeford, the son of Eliphalet and Eunice Butler Walker, and following his graduation from High School he went to Cornell University, where he received his degree as civil engineer.

Soon afterward he entered the employ of the Boston and Maine.

Subsequently he decided to study law and attended the law school at Yale University. He began the practice of that profession here in the

late 70's and continued until 1924 when he retired. At that time the firm was known as Walker and Walker, his son, Thomas B. Walker, being associated with him.

In addition to his service as mayor and in the Legislature he was for several years a member of the School Board. He was for some time a director of the First National Bank, the Pepperell Trust Company, and the Mutual Fire Insurance Company of Saco.

He was a member of Dunlap Lodge of Masons, York Chapter, Maine Council, Royal and Select Masters, Bradford Commandery, Knights Templar; and Kora Temple, Mystic Shrine.

Besides the son, Thomas B., he leaves a daughter, Miss Florence E. Walker, and four grandchildren.
