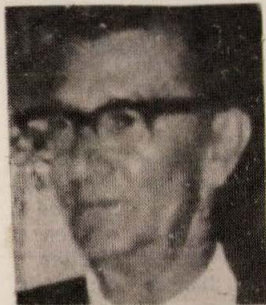

**BANGOR and CASTINE —** Douglas E. Wardwell, 63, died Aug. 5, 1991, at a Bangor hospital after a long illness. He was born in Castine, Nov. 1, 1927, the son of Frank and Ursula (Wardwell) Wardwell. David W. Warren, Jr., 84, of Rockland, died Jan. 14, 2004, at Penobscot Bay Medical Center, Rockport, after an extended illness.
