## Forrest C. 'Tick' Warren booster of athletics at Kennebunk

KENNEBUNK - Forrest C. "Tick" Warren, 81, of Warren's Way died Monday morning at the Evergreen Manor Nursing Home in Saco after a long illness.

He was born in Lyman, a son of Leonard P. and Luella Bachelder Warren, and attended schools in Lyman before attending Sanford High School for three years. He graduated from Kennebunk High School.

Mr. Warren began his sheetmetal apprenticeship at the Saco Lowell Shop for several years before going on to the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard, where he was employed for more than 20 years. He then worked five years at Kidder Press Inc. in Westbrook, where he retired at 62.

Mr. Warren was a strong supporter of Kennebunk High School's athletic program for more than 60 years, and received a plaque in appreciation for his efforts. He also received a football jersey at a KHS Alumni Old Timers Game several years ago, plus a lifetime pass to all KHS sporting events.

Mr. Warren enjoyed and encouraged children. They in turn enjoyed him, family members said.

The last honor given Mr. Warren was changing the name of his street from Pleasant Street to Warren's Way.

Mr. Warren played the electric guitar in a dance band for many years. Even after he retired, he continued playing for many nursing homes in the area.

He enjoyed gardening, farming, fishing and hunting. He was a member of the York County Fish and Game Club and the Ski Mobile Club, where he was treasurer for several years. He was also a founding member of the Mousam Saddle and Harness Club, a member of the York Lodge of Masons at West Kennebunk for 57 years and belonged to the Society for the Preservation of Ballroom Dancing.

Surviving are his wife of 58 years, Doris Hoyt Warren; a brother, William F. of Fort Myers, Fla., and Scarborough; and two sisters, Muriel Warren and Virginia Eregitano, both of Kennebunk.

Visiting hours will be from 2 to 4 and 7 to 9 p.m. Thursday at Bibber Memorial Chapel, 67 Summer St., where a funeral will be held at 11 a.m. Friday with the Rev. E. Lamar Robinson officiating. Burial will be in Hope Cemetery.
