Funeral Services for Herbert Kimball Washburn, 62, prominent in Masonry and for 40 years engaged in the drug business in this City, will be held Tuesday at 10 a. m., in the Congress Square Universalist Church. Interment will be in Thomaston, with committal services at the grave.

Mr. Washburn, who died early Sunday at his home, 58 Neal Street as the result of a heart attack, was born in Thomaston June 13, 1874, son of George S. and Emily Lermond Washburn. After learning the drug business in his native town he came to this City, where he had been engaged in the trade since 1896. He was a member of the firm of Washburn & Colcord at Spring and Brackett Streets.

RAYMOND O. WASHBURN

ORRINGTON - Raymond O. Washburn, 74, died peacefully Jan. 14, 2007, at a Bangor hospital after a short illness. He was born Aug. 18, 1932, in Bangor, the son of Albert and Dorothy (White) Washburn. Ray was a graduate of Hampden Academy and Williams College School of Banking. He was employed by the former Merrill Trust Co. for more than 30 years and was a well-respected part of the management team. After retirement, Ray worked at several companies and most recently at Darlings Honda dealership. He was a devoted member of East Orrington Congregational Church and held many leadership positions throughout his 33-year span, concluding as moderator for two terms and was, at the time of his death, a member of the board of elders. He was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force and completed a tour of duty in Korea during the Korean War from 1951 to 1952.
