Waldo Richard Weston, 55, a World War I veteran and a former member of the Bath police force, died suddenly at his home, 188 Center street, Wednesday evening. Funeral will be Saturday afternoon at two from the A. F. Mayo & Son Funeral residence, 819 High street, with Rev. Dr. David L. Wilson officiating. Burial will be in the family lot at Oak Grove.

Born in Altoona, Pa., January 26, 1895, a son of Herbert and Anna Edgely Weston, he had lived in Bath since 1918 when he was discharged from the Army. Before enlisting in the Army in 1914 Weston worked in Pennsylvania mines, on Texas ranches and in the wheat fields of Kansas.

His company was at the Portland Harbor Defenses and went to Fort Baldwin, Popham Beach, in 1917. After being recalled to Portland in 1918, he was scheduled to leave for New York on his way overseas on the day the Armistice was signed.

Weston was a Common Council member from Ward 6 in 1938; he was a member of the Smith-Tobey Post, A. L.; Polar Star lodge of Masons and a member of the Bath Aerie of Eagles.

Surviving besides his wife, Mrs. Alice Bowie Weston, of Bath, are a son, Waldo R. Weston, Jr., of Bath; a brother, Fred Weston, U. S. A., stationed in Germany; two half-brothers, Carl Weston of Harrisburg, Pa., and Paul Weston of Washington, D. C., a half sister, Mrs. Mudson Rutler of McKeesport, Pa.; and uncle and aunt, Mr. and Mrs. George Edgely of Altoona, Pa.; an aunt, Mrs. John Malone of Altoona, Pa., and a granddaughter.
