

Newport, Dec. 29. — Stricken ill on his birthday Wednesday, State Senator Carl Roe Weymouth, 45, a Republican, died this morning at his home on Main Street. Heart trouble was given as the cause of death. Funeral services will be held at his home Monday at 1.30 o'clock.

Mr. Weymouth was born at Newport, the son of J. Henry and May Roe Weymouth, and received his education in the Bangor schools and at the Allen School for Boys at West Newton, Mass. Upon completing his education he became manager for F. A. Maxwell & Company of Bangor. dealers in raw wool and hides. His father, a pioneer in the business, established the Weymouth Wool Company here 30 years ago and his son joined him after a few years in Bangor and succeeded to the management upon the father's death, the business in the meantime having been purchased by Swift & Company of Chicago. Three years ago, upon the plant being closed, Senator Weymouth engaged in the same business in Pittsfield and since had managed it.

An enthusiastic sportsman, Mr. Weymouth was a member of the Newport Rod and Gun Club and a leader in the club's presentation of land to the State for a fish rearing pool. He served as selectman of Newport from 1928 to 1931 and had served as State senator from Penobscot county since 1933, his present term expiring next week. He was a member of the various branches of Masonry and of Anah Temple of Mystic Shrine of Bangor.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Freda Brown Weymouth, to whom he was married in 1911, following the death of his first wife, Mrs. Bessie Sanborn Weymouth. He also leaves a daughter, Mrs. Barbara Weymouth wrkins. a son Jay Jenry Weymouth
