

Bowdoinham, July 30—Horace Whitney, 59, Topsham farmer, was killed by a Portland to Bangor passenger train this morning as he walked along the tracks two miles West of Bowdoinham Station.

MILLARD A. WHITNEY

MACHIAS - Millord A. Whitney. 90, died peacefully Oct. 22, 1993, at his home. He was born at Jonesboro. Feb. 26, 1903, the son of Charles C. and Julia May (Foss) Whitney. He was a graduate of Jonesboro High School and Washington State Normal School. Machias. He taught school at Cherryfield and Madrid before becoming headmoster at St. Andrews, an Episcopal school for boys in Barrington, R.I. He was a member and past master of Harwood Lodge No. 91 AF & AM and was a 32nd degree mason. He served as head of nine different masonic bodies and received the Josiah H. Drummond Medal in 1980. He was elected and served as grand high priest of the State of Maine in 1968, Millard is survived by his wife of 65 years.
