BANGOR — Freeman L. Wight, 99, a Bangor resident for many years, died Jan. 8, 1984, at a Bangor convalescent center. He was born in Houlton, Oct. 10, 1884, the son of Lewis S. and Laura (Mansur) Wight. He was educated in Massachusetts schools and Burdett Business College. He permanently located in Maine in 1914 and established a raw fir dealership business under the name of Barr-Wight Fur Company, located on State Street in Bangor, later known as the F.L. Wight Fur Company, Inc. He also established Wights's Sporting Goods, a landmark business in Bangor, now located in Brewer. In 1915 and 1916, he operated a scheduled bus line from Bangor to East Eddington. He served one term on the Bangor Board of Aldermen and served Bangor as a representative in the 93rd, 94th and 95th Legislatures. He represented Penobscot County as a senator in the 96th and 97th Legislatures, serving on the taxation committee, was chairman of the committee

of inland fisheries and game. Freeman traveled extensively in the U.S., Canada and Mexico, visiting all 50 states. Proceeds from showing his travel movies taken on his first transcontinental trip by auto in 1922, were given to the Sunshine Club for Crippled Children. He was a member of All Soul's Congregational Church; a 61-year member of St. Andrew's Lodge No. 83 of Bangor; the York and Scottish Rite Bodies, Valley of Bangor; Anah Temple Shrine; Bangor Grange and an honorary member of the Bangor Rotary Club. He was a life member of the Salvation Army advisory board and was an executive director for the State of Maine in the New England unit of the Wally Byam Caravan Club. He was predeceased by his wife, Florence in 1977. Surviving are one sister, Lucille Bowers of Sykesville, Md.; several nieces and nephews. Funeral services will be held 3 p.m. Tuesday at Brookings-Smith, 133 Center St., Bangor. Interment will be in Mount Hope Cemetery

Harry C. Wilbur, 63, of 5^c Highland Street, corporation counsel, died Sunday afternoon in the State Street Hospital after an illness of three weeks. He had been in failing health about three years but had been active at City Hall until his final illness. He entered the hospital two weeks ago.

Mr. Wilbur was born at Cloverdale, Calif., June 21, 1872, the son of Eben W. and Julia A. Wilbur, who moved to Portland in 1877. He was graduated from Portland High School in 1890 and from Bowdoin College in 1894. He was admitted to the Maine Bar in 1902.

Immediately after graduating from Bowdoin and until 1900 he was a school teacher in various schools in the State. For 20 years he was as-

sociated in law practice with Justice Arthur Chapman of the Superior Court.

He was first appointed Corporation Counsel by Mayor Charles B. Clarke and served a term under Portland's last mayor, Judge of Probate Carroll S. Chaplin. When the City Manager-Council form of government was adopted in 1923 he was reappointed Corporation Counsel by City Manager Harry A. Brinkerhoff.

He was a member of the Sea and Shores Fisheries Commission for several years.

While at Bowdoin College Mr. Wilbur was particularly active in athletics and was a member of the varsity football team. He studied law in the office of Gage & Strout in Portland. For several years he was associated with the late Fabius M. Ray, one of the leading probate lawyers in Cumberland County.

Years ago he took an active interest in Republican politics and for three successive terms, 1915, 1916 and 1917, he was chairman of the Republican City Committee. He managed many county and city campaigns.

Mrs. Wilbur, the former Ida E. Godfrey, died last year.

Mr. Wilbur was a Mason, a member of the Portland Athletic Club, the Cumberland County Fish and Game Association, the Cumberland Bar Association, and the Zeta Psi Fraternity. He served on numerous committees for the American Bar Association representing the Maine Bar Association.
