PORTLAND - Lt. Col. Lawrence A. Willett, 89, of Kent Street in Portland, died unexpectedly Saturday, May 10, 2003, at Maine Medical Center. He was born in Mt. Chase, a son of Stanley and Gladys (Finson) Willett. Lt. Col. Willett was a graduate of Mattanawcook Academy in Lincoln. He was also a graduate of Wentworth Institute in Boston, Mass. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II, and for many years was a member of the U.S. Army Reserves. For four years he owned Willett's Market at Deering Center. He later went to work for Commercial Union Insurance Company as a safety engineer and retired from there in 1979. During his tenure there he offered classes in electrical safety, which helped to reduce the number of work related electrical deaths in the state of Maine. He was a member of Woodford's Congregational Church, the Woodford's Club, and the Masons. He enjoyed boating on Sebago Lake and was a self-taught craftsman, who could tackle any project that came along. He was predeceased by his first wife, Claire (Ennis) Willett in 1980; his second wife, Ruth (Bennett) Willett in 1993; and a son, Robert P. Willett in 2002. Surviving are a daughter, Clover Jordan of Portland and her children, Jeffrey A. Jordan of Middletown, Conn., and Todd R. Jordan of Atlanta, Ga.; three stepchildren, William, Eva and Dean; and sister-in-law Louise Libby of Gorham and her children, Wayne Libby of Gorham, and Kathryn Austin of Rhinebeck, N.Y.
