Winslow, 40, Machias dentist, was killed instantly, and his 16-year-old daughter, Jean, suffered injuries from which she died at 4 a. m. today at the Ellsworth City Hospital, when the sedan in which they were driving from Ellsworth to Machias was in head-on collision late Saturday night at the junction of the Calais and Lamoine roads with a coupe owned by the Mawhinney Motor Company of Machias and operated by Orrin W. Marshall of Jonesboro.

Marshall, who suffered chest

injuries and severe cuts, was treated at the hospital and taken to his home today.

State Highway Patrolman Adelbert Sargent of this city and Dr. Charles C. Knowlton, Hancock County medical examiner, are conducting an investigation.

Marshall and Gordon Marston of Machias were on the way from Boston driving two new cars for the Mawhinney Company when the accident occurred. Marston, seeing the Winslow machine approaching, turned to the side of the road, but Marshall was unable to swing far enough to avoid the crash, he told investigating officials.

Dr. Winslow's neck was broken and his skull fractured, Dr. Knowlton said, and his daughter suffered head injuries.

Their bodies were taken today to the undertaking rooms of W. W. Bucknam at Machias.

Dr. Winslow, a native of St. Louis, Mo., where he received his education, had been a resident of Machias for the last 10 years, and he was a member of the Masonic bodies, including the Order of the Mystic Shrine. The daughter was an outstanding pupil at Machias High School, where she was prominent in scholastic and musical organizations, and she also was engaged in Girl Scout activities.

Dr. Winslow leaves his widow, the former Helen Rogers of Jonesport, and a younger daughter, Virginia.

Howard Winslow, 84, former State Senator and until his retirement six years ago one of Portland's most widely known business men, died Saturday at his home, 21 Sheffield Street, after an illness of more than a year.

Born in this City, Mr. Winslow began his business career in 1864, two years before the big fire, when at the age of 13 he was a clerk in a fruit store. After being employed in the office of the New York Life Insurance Company from 1870 to 1872, he entered the lumber business, an industry with which he was connected for 53 years.

His association with the late John W. Deering, former mayor of Portland, began in 1876 when Mr. Winslow became bookkeeper and clerk for the Southern Pine Lumber Company, of which Mr. Deering was the head. Re-

maining with the concern after it became known as the Deering-Richardson Company, he was admitted to the firm in 1887. The concern, thenceforth known as the Deering-Winslow Company, was incorporated in 1895 with Mr. Winslow as treasurer.

After the death of Mr. Deering, Sr., in 1904, Mr. Winslow became president. Out of his busy mercantile career, he in 1911 and 1912 took time to serve in the State Senate as the sole Democratic representative from Portland. At one time he was president of the Songo River Line, Inc., operating steamboats on Sebago Lake, Songo River, Bay of Naples and Long Lake.

With the arrival of a White Steamer automobile here in the early part of the current century, he became the owner and operator of the first gasoline car in this City. He was instrumental and shared in the formation of the first motor car law passed by the Maine Legislature.

He was a 32nd Degree Mason, Odd Fellow, Knight of the Golden Eagle,

Red Man, Knight of Malta and member of the Woodfords Club, Kiwanis Club and Kora Shrine.

Surviving him are two sons, Clifford of South Portland and Charles H. Winslow of Portland, and nine grandchildren. His wife died last July.

## Maine Guide, colorful storyteller

CAPE ELIZABETH — Sidney H. Winslow, 74, a longtime Maine Guide, storyteller and telephone lineman, died Tuesday at his home on Fenway Road.

Mr. Winslow was a colorful storyteller who enjoyed relating experiences from his 50 years of work as a Maine Guide in the Rangeley region.

"He took people hunting and fishing," said his son, Mark Winslow. "If they just wanted to see the back side of Sugarloaf Mountain, he'd take them up there and cook them dinner."

"A wealthy man once wanted his young son to catch a 5-pound trout," said his son. "Well, my father took him out and got a trout on his own line. He saw a moose and calf so he pointed them out to the boy, and then switched lines. The boy's father gave him a \$50 tip."

### PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

Mr. Winslow always changed his stories slightly every time he told them, said his stepdaughter, Cheryl Cook. "A lot of them were humorous. A lot of them were fish stories — tall tales. Nobody minded. Everybody heard them hundreds of times."

Mr. Winslow had a camp in Township 6, just across the border from Madrid, and he named it Number 6 camp, said his son. "He had a cat that he found up there, and he named her 'Number 6.'"

He always enjoyed the outdoors. "You'd find him up to camp just about every weekend. He cut and stacked his own wood up until last winter. He wasn't very mechanical but he could sure tie a fly."

"He was a wonderful raconteur," said John "Jack" Erier, a longtime friend. "He lived life to the fullest and told wonderful stories about his experience. He taught me a love for the outdoors, and particularly the love of stone walls. He used them as landmarks while making his way through the woods."

Mr. Winslow worked 37 years for the New England Telephone Co. as a lineman, cable splicer, installer and test man, retiring in 1983. He worked in Rangeley and Kennebunk and later in the Portland area.

Mr. Winslow was proud of the fact that he was installing the telephones into Rangeley in 1955 at about the time President Dwight Eisenhower visited Rangeley to go fishing, said his son.

During World War II Mr. Winslow served in the Army in the 45th Mobile Repair and Reclamation Squadron.

He was a member of the Masons, the 60 Plus Club in Portland and the Telephone Co. Pioneers of America.

Born in South Portland, a son of Frank Herbert and Pauline Frances Small Winslow, he graduated in 1940 from South Portland High School.

His wife, Barbara Hiller Winslow, died in 1992.

Surviving are a son, Mark S. of Old Orchard Beach; a daughter, Carolyn Johnson of Danvers, Mass.; five stepchildren, Robinson Cook III of South Portland, John Hiller Cook of Raymond, Cheryl Cook of Portland, Timothy C.
