Capt. Albert S. Woodbury

Capt. Albert S. Woodbury, 80, of 11 Oak Street, South Portland, former master mariner and later a building contractor in that city, died today in the State Street Hospital. He had a shock following a fall Sunday,

when he broke his hip.

Born at South Portland May 16, 1862, Capt. Woodbury first sailed with his father, Capt. Stephen Woodbury on the Lady Woodbury and the J. P. Macheca. 
CHARLES S. WOODBURY
