Auburn, Jan. 29.—John W. Wood, 71, president of Wood and Smith Shoe Company of Auburn, died today at his home, 39 Pine Street, after a long illness.

A native of Malton, Ont., he was the son of Mary Couchman Wood and the late John Wood.

Mr. Wood was educated in Ontario and graduated from the Freeport High School. He began his business career at Freeport with A. W. Shaw and Company in 1892, remained there until 1912, then became a salesman for the Stetson-Abbott Company, a subsidiary of the Dingley-Foss Company, long active in Auburn.

Early in 1917, Mr. Wood became associated with the Norway Shoe Company and was its president and general manager until 1919. In that same year, he founded the Wood and Smith Company here. For 12 years, he was a vice president and director of the Portland Morris Plan Bank, and one of the founders of the Lewiston branch. He was also a director of the Manufacturers National Bank, Lewiston. He was chairman of the board of trustees at the Elm Street Universalist Church; a member of

Masonic orders including the Shrine, and of the Rotary and Executive Clubs.

Survivors are his widow, Mrs. Eula Bicknell Wood of Auburn, three

brothers, Horace Wood of Readfield, Charles Wood of Manitoba, and Gwelph Wood of Ontario.



Lester Wood Sr.,^{#4/10} organized town's fire department

EAST BALDWIN — Lester W. Wood Sr. of Woods Mill Road, a lifelong resident who ran his family's lumber mill and helped organize the town's fire department, died April 1, 2000, at Mercy Hospital after a brief illness. He was 82.

Mr. Wood was a family man and an outdoorsman who loved fishing and hunting.

He was the son of Frank E. and Elsie Sanderson Wood, and lived his entire life in the house where he was born. He attended local schools and graduated from Standish High School.

As a young man, he started working at his father's lumber mill, and he and his brother, Leroy, took over operation of the mill.

"He always joked that back in the '50s, his father went to Florida and left him and his brother with \$500 to run the business," said Lester H. Wood, his son. "(His father) told him, 'If you make it, fine. If you don't, close the doors.' And we're still here."

Mr. Wood and his brother operated the mill through many changes before retiring in 1984. They once made lettuce crates for farmers in Cape Elizabeth. "I used to nail them together when I was a kid," his son said.

During World War II, the mill manufactured ammunition boxes, a duty that prevented Mr. Wood from serving in the military during wartime. The mill now makes pallets for industry.

On June 28, 1939, he married Alice Howard Wood. He enjoyed spending time with his family, which grew to include 21 great-grandchildren.

He served as a road commissioner for Baldwin for many years and served on the State Conservation Commission. He was one of the founders of the Baldwin Volunteer Fire Department after the fires of 1947, and he was recognized by the town for that in 1998.

Mr. Wood was a member of the East Baldwin Congregational Church. He served on the Baldwin School Board, was involved with the Boy Scouts, and was an organizer for the Baldwin Belt Burners snowmobile club. He was a member of the Greenleaf Masonic Lodge, Kora Shrine and the North Baldwin Grange.

He also was a fisherman and hunter. He used to enter his name in the state's annual moose hunting lottery and then go with his wife to watch the drawings. His other pastimes included four-wheeling, feeding deer at his home, vegetable gardening, camping, and his Wednesday night cribbage games.
