WALTER W. WOODBURY

BRUNSWICK — Walter Worthley Woodbury, 92, of 10A Jordan Avenue, died yesterday at a local nursing home after a six month illness.

He was born at Patten, June 20, 1876, son of Timothy J. and Phyllena Boynton Woodbury. He was educated in Patten schools and was married there Aug. 27, 1903, to the former Lottie Chase. He operated the Huston Clothing Company there for many years.

He came to Brunswick in 1923 and joined the Remington Arms Co. as a salesman and shooting representative. A long time friend of Billy Hill, famous sharpshooter, Woodbury became interested in firearms and it

was through Hill's influence that he became affiliated with Remington for 16 years.

An outstanding marksman, Mr. Woodbury once shot a straight 203, which is still a field shooting record.

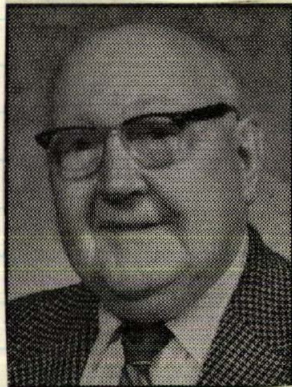

Lloyd Goodale Woodman, 43, treasurer of the M. Woodman Insurance company, with headquarters in the Masonic building in this city, a life-long resident of the two cities, widely known in local, county and state Masonic circles, died at a local hospital early this morning following a brief illness.

Born in Saco, the son of the late Melville and Annetta (Furness) Woodman, his parents moved to this city when he was young and his education was obtained in the local public and high schools. Besides his wife, the former Edna Ramberg, a son, Richard M., and two daughters, Marjorie J. and Joan S. Woodman, all of this city, he leaves four brothers, Percy L., New Orleans, La.; Philip of Tennessee, King and Paul M. of this city; a sister, Mrs. Philip I. Towle, East Orange, N. J., and several nieces and nephews.
