grandchildren.



Samuel Russell Wyman, 89, a longtime carpenter and mechanic who enjoyed Saturday night dances and the Boston Red Sox, died Monday at the Barron Center.

Mr. Wyman held a variety of occupations during his long working career. In the 1920s, he was a woodsman and a truck driver for his father at the family's portable sawmill. They bought PASSAGES

wood lots in Maine and New Hampshire and cut and milled the trees on site

My grandfather had a ready source of laborers in his 13 children," said Mr. Wyman's son, Donaid Wyman. "They all pitched in, doing whatever, to make the sawmill operation go. When the land had been cleared of its useful timber, they would move to another lot."

The portable sawmill was a primitive opera-tion, using mostly man-

ual labor."My grandfather used to employ finish woodchoppers with double-bitted axes. My father used to work the teams of horses in the woods, yarding the logs that were cut during the day."

In the 1930s, Mr. Wyman worked at constructing electrical power lines in New Hampshire and Massachusetts. He also was a miner in a feldspar quarry in Gilsum, N.H., and an auto mechanic for several years at his brother's garage in Alton, N.H.

When World War II broke out, he was working as a carpenter. He ended up moving to Portland to work on the construction of some of the buildings at the South

Portland shipyards.

He settled in the Stroudwater neighborhood and for many years worked as a maintenance carpenter for the Pocahontas Coal Co. on Commercial Street in Portland. That large coal operation was on Long Wharf, now the site of DiMillo's Restaurant and Marina. They had big cranes that dug coal out of the barges and into railroad gondola cars," said his son.

Before retiring in the late 1960s, Mr. Wyman was an auto mechanic and body man for Elwell's Garage and Marster's Chevrolet, both in Westbrook

Born in Lincoln, a son of Fred Darling and Delia Hersey Wyman, he attended schools in Lincoln, Porter

and Manchester, N.H. For many years, Mr. Wyman and his wife, Ruth Wiggett Pratt Wyman, enjoyed dancing every Saturday

He was a lifelong fan of the Boston Red Sox. "Most everybody else had given them up two or three times," said his son, "but he still hung on

Mrs. Wyman died in 1987 after 61 years of marriage. Besides Stroudwater, they lived in Westbrook and East Sebago.
