Three years later, in 1959, Mr. Yorke traveled to Washington, D.C., to become a member of the bar of the United State Supreme Court. The oath of office was administered by Chief Justice Earl Warren.

Mr. Yorke's admittance to the bar, proposed by Supreme Court Assistant Librarian Edward G. Hudon, allowed him to practice law before the nation's highest court.

Mr. Yorke was born in South Portland, son of Alton L. and Elva Yorke Sr. He later lived in Cape Elizabeth for many years before moving to his current Anderson Road address.

Mr. Yorke was a graduate of South Portland High School, and later worked as a welder at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. He then served in the Navy in the Pacific Theater during World War II.

He was a claim representative for the U.S. Fidelity & Guarantee Co. before entering law school.

Mr. Yorke was a member the Hiram Masonic Lodge and the Shrine.

Surviving are his wife, Eileen E. Yorke; two sons, Steven of Hebrandston Cross, Wales, and Richard C. of St. Cloud, Minn.; a daughter, Mrs. Robert (Dorothy) Morton of Casco; a stepson, Michael T. Jordan of Windham; and 10 grandchildren.
