Young, husband of Florence Barnes Young of Rockland, has been missing since Jan. 5, following action off Bari, Italy. He was born at South Deer Isle, the son of Capt. William and Flossie Young, and went to sea at the age of 13 with his father, who at one time was a crew member on the famous America's Cup defender Columbia. His parents make their home at Ingraham's Field, Rockland.

In 1919 Young went into the Merchant Marine service and followed it for four years and was a graduate of a navigation school under Capt. Charles McGee of Rockland. For nine years he was aboard Mrs. Mabel Baldrige's yacht at Warrenton, Glen Cove.

In January, 1943, he joined the merchant service again as third officer on a boat and was soon promoted to second officer and at the time he was reported missing was applying for his chief mate's papers.

Young was a seventh degree Granger, past Pomona master of Limerock Valley, and past master of Rockland Lodge of Masons, a member of the Order of the Eastern Star and of the Methodist Church. He has two children Barbara L. Young 15

## Newman Young, Ex-Coach, Dies

POMPANO BEACH, Fla. — Newman H. Young, 72, widely known Maine basketball and football official, died here today following a long illness.

He was the husband of the former Ruby Hackett.

He was born Nov. 1, 1897, in Lewiston, Maine, son of Nathaniel and C. Bertha Glidden Young, and graduated from Lewiston High School and Maine Central Institute where he was active in athletics.

He coached at the former Abbott School in Farmington, Maine, where he had the prep school basketball champions in 1925. He moved to Westbrook, Maine, in the fall of the same year to teach and coach all three varsity sports.

Mr. Young moved to Portland, Maine, in the early 1930's to work for the Cumberland County Power and Light Co., which eventually became the Portland Transportation Co.

During the years just prior to his move to Florida where he was active in real estate, he was in the wholesale poultry business.
